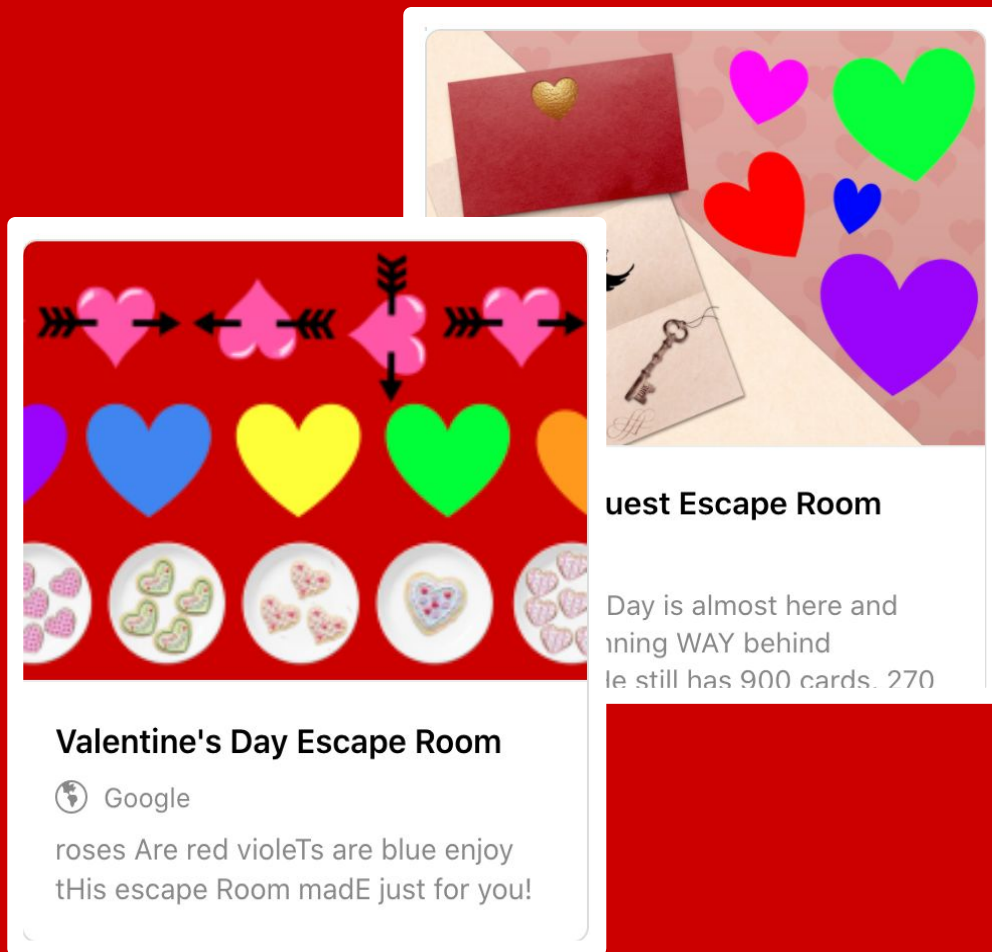


Two FREE Valentine's Day Digital Escape Rooms

Getting Started with Digital Escape Rooms

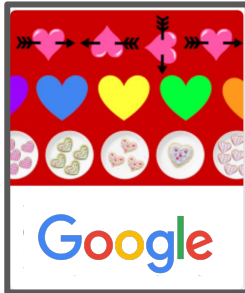

A fun and simple digital escape room. Perfect for first time escapers or younger students.

MS Version



5 Letter Word Lock: HEART

Bold and large letters in the text spell out heart.

5 Digit Number Lock: 64318

Cookies are grouped together on plates order from left to right.

6 Directional Lock: URLDRU

Arrows are pointing in a direction. Follow from left to right.

5 Color Lock: PBYGO

Colored hearts are ordered from left to right.

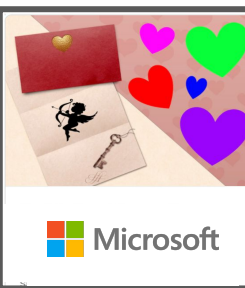
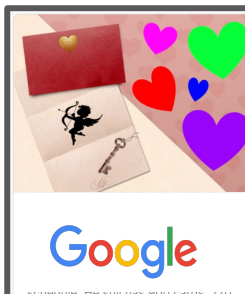
Date Lock: 2/14

Question on the form asks for the date we celebrate Valentine's day.

Cupid's Quest

A fun Valentine's day themed escape room.

MS Version



4 Digit Number Lock: 1585

The numbers in the introduction text add up to 1585.

5 Directional Lock: SENWN

Cupid links to a Google map. Follow the order of the list of towns beginning with Diamond, ID and ending with Lily, SD.

5 Letter Word Lock: CANDY

Key is linked to a jigsaw planet puzzle reveals candy hearts with the word CANDY.

2 Digit Number Lock: 18

Pink heart links to an emoji math puzzle .

5 Color Lock: BPRGP

Hearts are colored. Order is from smallest to largest.

DK Find Out link does not lead to a clue. It's just fun information
