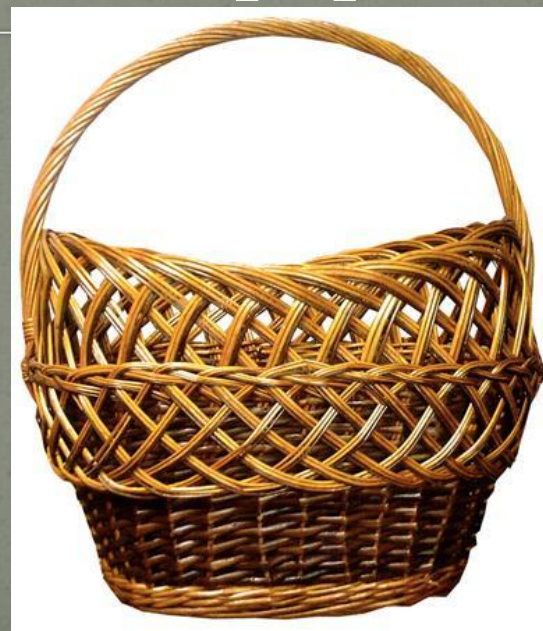

+ Noun + V² / V + ed

They **visited** London last year.

My parents **bought** me a new bike
yesterday.

Negative form

-Noun + **did not (didn't)**+V1

They **didn't** visit London last year.

- My parents **didn't buy** me a new bike yesterday.

Past Simple

Question form

? **Did** + noun + **V1** ?

Did they visit London last year?

Did your parents **buy** a new bike yesterday?

Yes, I/you/we/they/he/she/it **did**

No, I/you/we/they/he/she/it **did not**

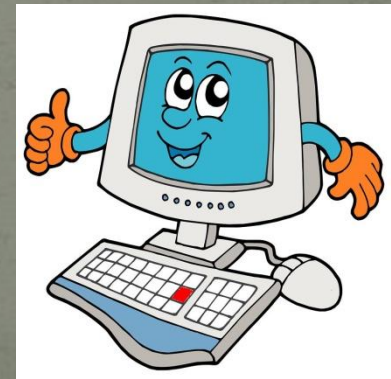
