### Noun + did not (didn't)+V1

### They didn't visit London last year.

My parents **didn't buy** me a new bike yesterday.

# Past Simple Question form

### ? **Did** +noun + V1 ?

Did they visit London last year? Did your parents buy a new bike yesterday?

Yes, I/you/we/they/he/she/it did No, I/you/we/they/he/she/it did not (didn't)






