Methods

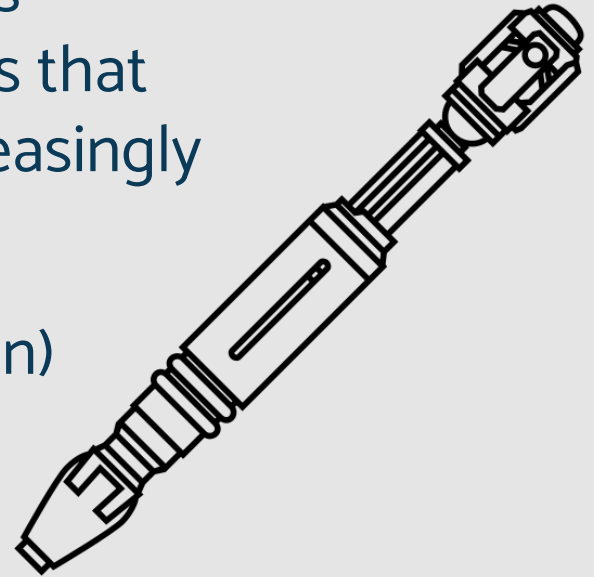


- Watched a lot of Doctor Who (New Who)

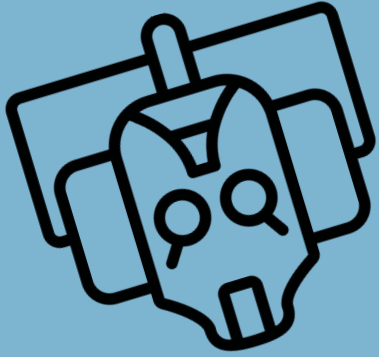

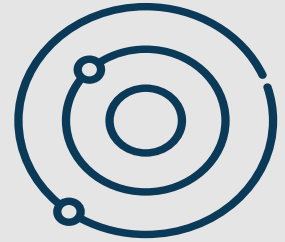
