Key Vocabulary

Development	Development means people reaching an acceptable standard of living or quality of life.
Quality of life	Quality of life means the general well-being of people, which includes income, health, education, employment and the environment.
HDI - Human Development Index	Created to better measure development, including GNI, life expectancy and education
Literacy Rate	The proportion of the adult population aged 15 years and over which is literate - can read and write
Birth Rate	The number of live births per 1000 of the population per year
GNI - Gross National Income	This is the dollar value of a country's final income in a year, divided by its population.
Development Gap	The development gap refers to the widening gap between the richest and poorest countries of the world.
SDGS	A new set of 17 targets – Sustainable Development Goals SDGs by the UN United Nations
Sustainability	Sustainability is when materials and resources are used in a way that will balance the needs of the present, without compromising the future.
