She then went through several surgeries which left her on crutches for many years. That didn't stop her from running or mountain biking and her dad was her first cycling training partner, racing mountain bikes with her in Alaska. Sam lettered in swimming and bowling in high school and earned a crew scholarship to the University of Central Florida where she rowed for two years before pursuing cycling full-time.
