



How do I replace a lost or broken STPP Youth Clipper card?

- 1. You must call (877) 878-8883, Mon-Fri between 6 AM 8 PM; Sat & Sun between 8 AM 5 PM.
- 2. You must pay a \$3.00 replacement fee over the phone, using a credit card number.
- 3. Explain to the Clipper Customer Service representative:
 - a. "I am an OUSD student and I lost my Student Transit Pass Clipper Card."
 - b. "I need to order a replacement card."
 - c. "My OUSD email address is @ousd.org."
 - d. "My OUSD student ID number is #_____."
 - e. "My mailing address is , Oakland, California."
 - f. "Here is a credit card number: xxxx-xxxx-xxxx, Expiration date MM-YYYY, security code xxx."
- 4. In about 10 days, your replacement Clipper card will arrive in your mailbox.
- 5. When you receive it, you can add it to your digital wallet on <u>iPhone</u> or <u>Android</u>.






Driver Education @ CCPA

- Driver Education is a class that teaches you about traffic laws, road safety, driver responsibilities, and avoiding accidents. It DOES NOT INCLUDE Behind-The-Wheel training. It is NOT a college class.
- If you are under age 18, you must complete a Driver Education course before getting your <u>instruction permit</u> (which allows you to legally practice behind-the-wheel).
- Completing this 1-semester class earns you 1 semester of elective credit, which counts towards graduation.
- CCPA sometimes offers **Driver Education** in the spring semester. Students may request enrollment, but enrollment is not guaranteed.


- In "Dual Enrollment" classes, students earn both high school credit AND college credit at the same time.
- Before enrolling, you must complete a
 California Community Colleges (CCC) Application
 at <u>cccapply.org</u> to obtain a student ID. Your ID
 arrives via email and looks like this: AYY2036
 (You only have to do this once, not every year.)
- Then, you must <u>use that ID</u> to enroll in specific college classes using the DE form:


