Using Scratch, present at least one concrete action you can take to help achieve the **Responsible Consumption and Production** goal.

To take on this challenge, you will need to follow certain criteria.

Content of the animation or game

Your animation or game should include the following elements :

<input type="checkbox"/>	at least one concrete action you can take
<input type="checkbox"/>	at least two backdrops
<input type="checkbox"/>	at least two sprites
<input type="checkbox"/>	at least one sound or audio recording
<input type="checkbox"/>	at least one dialogue between two sprites
<input type="checkbox"/>	one interaction (ex.: question) with the user



Content of your Scratch program

Your program should include the following elements :

<input type="checkbox"/>	motion blocks to animate your sprites
<input type="checkbox"/>	at least one sensing block (ex.: to ask a question to the user)
<input type="checkbox"/>	at least one conditional statement
<input type="checkbox"/>	at least one loop
<input type="checkbox"/>	at least two different event blocks
<input type="checkbox"/>	an animation between 2 and 4 minutes

Elements related to publication

To publish your project, you should:

<input type="checkbox"/>	have a meaningful title followed by Kreocode 2023 (e.g.: Game About Recycling - Kreocode 2023)
<input type="checkbox"/>	use images, photos or sounds that are copyright free (no photo or personal information of students)
<input type="checkbox"/>	cite any sources used in the space reserved for <i>Notes and Credits</i>
<input type="checkbox"/>	pay close attention to your use of language
<input type="checkbox"/>	indicate how to start your program in the <i>Instructions</i> section (if it does not start with the green flag)
<input type="checkbox"/>	share the project (* once your project is complete)
