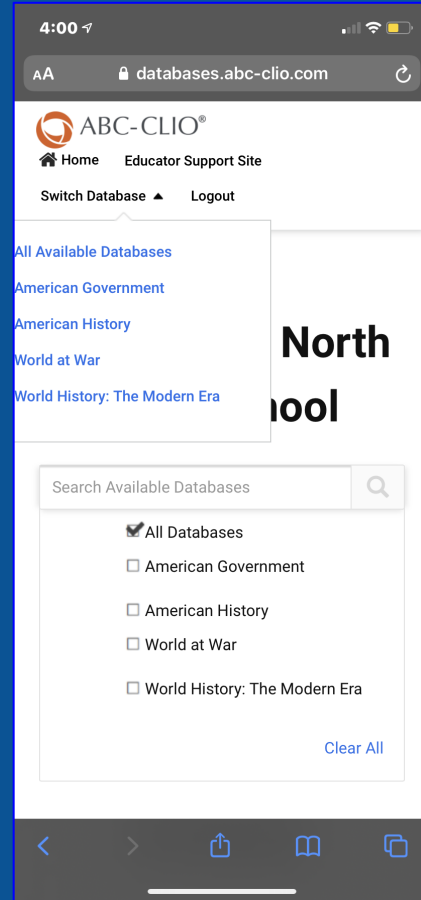

Biographies

Abdullah II is the king of Jordan. Born in Amman, Jordan, on January 30, 1962, Abdullah ibn al-Hussein was the eldest son of King [Hussein I](#) and Princess Muna al-Hussein. Abdullah and his 10 brothers and sisters are 43rd-generation direct descendants of the Prophet Muhammad. Abdullah attended the Islamic Educational College in Amman and St. Edmund's School in Surrey, [England](#). His [secondary education](#) occurred at Eaglebrook School and Deerfield Academy in the United States.
