Once, the question is drawn, it will show them their question and the prep time will continue to run until it is their turn to speak. If they leave the page or come back to it on a different device, it will show them the correct prep time left and the question they drew earlier.

# Default Timing

- First Speaker
  - 2 Minutes to Draw
  - 30 Minutes of Prep
- Other Speakers
  - 10 Minutes After Previous Speaker's Draw Ends Their Draw Starts
  - 2 Minutes of Draw Period
  - 30 Minutes of Prep (Prep Starts Regardless of Whether Or Not Student Has Drawn)
- Example: Round Start (11:00am)
  - Speaker 1 Can Draw From 11:00am to 11:02am
  - Speaker 1 Prep Runs From 11:02am and 11:32am (Can Still Draw)
  - Speaker 2 Can Draw From 11:12am to 11:14am
  - Speaker 2 Prep Runs From 11:14am to 11:44am (Can Still Draw)
  - Speaker 3 Can Draw From 11:24am to 11:26am
  - Speaker 3 Prep Runs From 11:26am to 11:56am (Can Still Draw)
  - Etc.

# Final Notes

- Students do not need to make separate accounts and tournament administration does not need to enter any data about the students (integrated with Tabroom). They must only supply the questions for the rounds and round schedule.
- Speaker order is pulled from Tabroom data or a CSV and does not rely on the speaker being on a certain page/room. You can assign prep rooms however you want (room number, speaker order, etc).
- Once a student has seen three questions, no matter which browser they login from or how many times they refresh, they will see the same three questions.
- Draw and Prep Times are based off of the round start time and so if a student doesn't show up or has any issues, future speakers will not be affected in any way.
- The admin can see which questions each speaker drew and assign the speaker a question manually.
- All data is saved server-side and so if a student reloads the page or logs in from a different device, it will show them the last screen shown to them (with updated times).
