Laptops

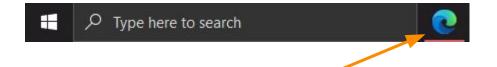
- As long as you're part of the program, you're welcome to use your laptop

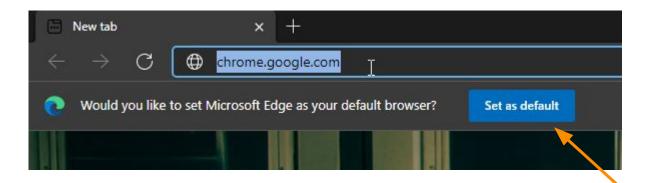
If so, awesome! Be on the lookout for people around you who are less experienced and help them out - then we can get onto the really fun stuff.

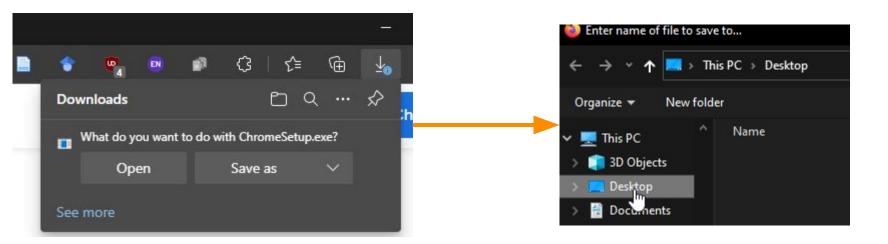

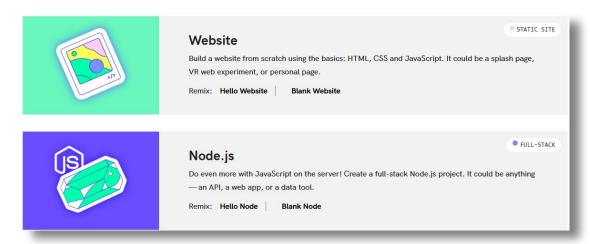

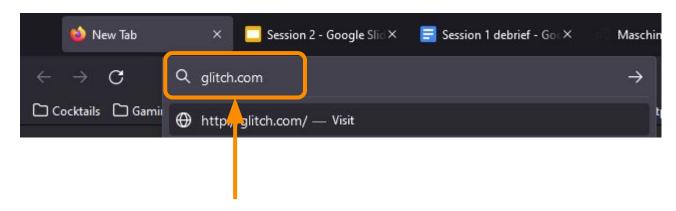

What's Glitch?



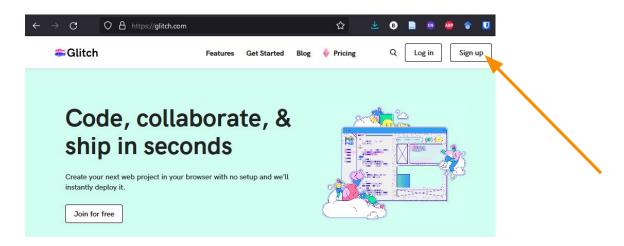
- Make websites with a website (Xzibit would approve)

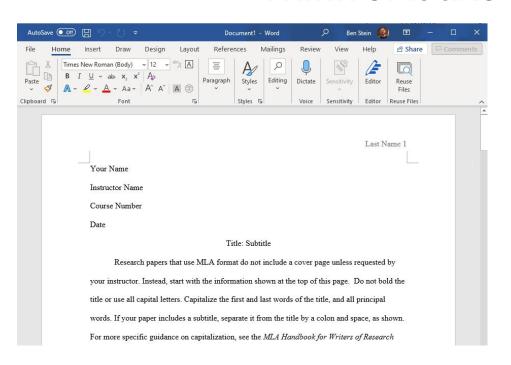

What *actually* is a website?

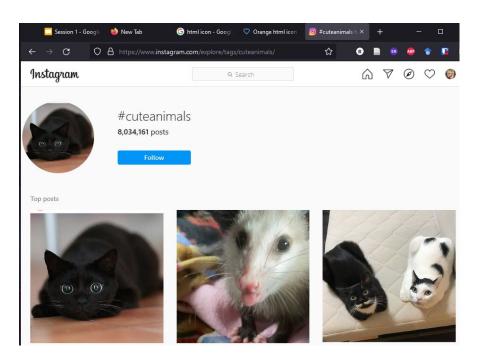
- We all use them every day, but how are they made?

In case of extra website time

- There are 3 basic building blocks of a modern webpage
 - \circ HTML: lets us decide WHAT is on the page \equiv
 - "Style" sheets: Lets us decide how stuff on the page LOOKS 👀
 - Scripts: Lets us decide how the user can INTERACT with the page



- Today we changed the HTML of the document to add new text, change existing text, etc.
- Soon we'll learn more about that AND learn about styling and scripting
- It's gonna be fun!

Talking more about servers and clients

- Servers are like the brain of an application, or whatever
- Clients talk to the server to bring the application to the world!
- Lots of clients (of different kinds, even), but only "one" server
