



 - Instill pride, dignity, and honor in being a member of the Order.



- Councils missed Star recognition because of missing 1728, SP-7, FBNs, or SE noncompliance (background checks).
 - Simple checks to assure that members do not appear on sex offender lists.
 - No Financial or Credit Checks.
 - Safe Environment COMPLETE within the first 2 months.

Common Question: I Can't Access Member Management?

How do I do this?

- ☐ Grand knights and financial secretaries who do not have an account registered to access Member Management can create their account in a matter of minutes after receiving their Invitation Code.
- □ To get your Invitation Code, have your membership number in hand, and contact Customer Service Department at (800) 380-9995.
- ☐ Customer Service can also assist officers who have forgotten their username and/or password.

Form 11077, Fraternal Benefit Night Reporting Changes For This Year

Use Form 11077 same as last year, except

- 11077 will be submitted directly to Supreme by councils
- The new required sum total attendance for 2 required FBNs:
 - Councils under 100: A combined total of 10 participants
 - Councils over 100: A combined total of 14 participants
 - Submit 11077 within seven (7) days of the Fraternal Benefits event.





Supreme Membership Intake Goal Reduction

Supreme MAJOR Membership Reduction of 5% if the State is able to obtain 50% of intake goals (395/2 = 198 members) by December 31, 2023.

History

 The Online Membership system was introduced in 2018 in an effort to make joining easier and less time consuming for the candidates for membership in today's fast paced world. I am convinced that it is a valuable and indispensable tool for getting new members to join.

Statistics

- FY 2018 2019 68 new members initiated
- FY 2019 2020 53 new members initiated
- FY 2020 2021 228 new members initiated
- FY 2021 2022 196 new members initiated with 128 members, 65%, transferring to a local council.
- FY 2022 6/28/2023 249 new members initiated with 157 members, 63%, transferring to a local council.
- Overall intake of Online Members since inception, 828 with 539, 65%, converted to councils.

Statistics

- I am concerned with the slight, 2% decline in transfers to local councils.
- We are missing an excellent opportunity to grow our councils, to grow our membership, and provide more resources to increase the performance of the good works that we all do throughout our parishes, our state, our nation, and our world.



I will get deeper into how the Online Membership process works in our meeting this afternoon so I will not put you through having to listen to that twice.

How it works

- A candidate joins online at <u>www.kofc.org/joinus</u> on a computer or by cell phone or tablet.
- He receives free dues for one year, a limited time offer currently running through 6/30/2022, by using the promo code BlessedMcGivney during the registration process
- Upon joining the Order, the new member counts toward the new member goal of the Alabama State Council
- The new online member can remain an online member for life, if he prefers, or he can transfer to a local council **after** viewing or participating in an in person combined exemplification.
- Once the new online member has viewed the combined ceremonial, he may transfer to a local council, by making application, going through the council's admission committee process and being accepted and transferred into the council. Once he is transferred to a council, he counts as a new member toward the council's new member goal and he can participate in the good works of the council and enjoy the experience of a lifetime.

Potential Setbacks To Be Aware Of

The verification process requires that the applicant have an active email address and be capable of receiving email on his phone in order to verify that he is who he says he is, etc. It has been suggested that Supreme change to a text message verification in an effort to make this process easier for the candidate.

Advantages

- The process is quick and easy for the busy young candidates living in today's world.
- It is available on a platform that most potential members are familiar with, phone, tablet, computer.
- It makes them members, with no wait for a degree ceremony to be scheduled, and they begin to receive information from Supreme to help them become more familiar with the Knights of Columbus while they await admission committee approval, view or attend the combined ceremonial, and are transferred, if that is their desire.
- Remember that anyone, including family members of the new member, can view the combined ceremony at any time and it is not necessary to await admission committee approval to get this step done. If they have viewed the ceremony when they are approved by the Committee, they can immediately be transferred to a council.

Thoughts going forward

- New officers gaining access to Officers Online, check your Prospect Tab for e-members assigned to your council. You may have a great start on your new member goals for the year and one of the hardest goals we have to achieve to qualify for Star Council Status.
- Contact them and see if you can get them transferred into your council.
- If something prevents their being transferred into your council, please reject them. There is nothing wrong with rejecting them, that is the reason for this option in the system, and you will reduce the clutter in the system. When rejecting a candidate, you will be asked to choose a reason from three choices. Choose the one that best fits and go forward. You are not kicking them out of the Knights of Columbus, you are helping to keep the system manageable.


