

# Workstream 1: Health/Monitoring

  - New plug-in architecture has been merged.
  - Indicio network PR
  - Bug fix
- Sovrin Steward compliance reviews
  - Work items have been broken down into tickets for the associated projects.

- Node Selection Algorithm - To ensure a healthy network
  - Starting to investigate the [Node Selection Algorithm SIP](#), and [Draft Proposal for Rewarding Validators via Proof of Contribution to Consensus](#) concepts more.

# Workstream 2: Technical

- **Node and Plenum** - Ubuntu 20.04 upgrade work is ongoing.
    - Robin Klemens completed the first pass of CD publishing into the new Hyperledger Debian repository (supporting 16.04 builds only).
    - Release artifacts are migrating to [Hyperledger Artifactory](#).
    - Integration of GHA CI/CD processes into the 20.04 upgrade branches:
      - Plenum - CI in progress, CD not started; summary [here](#).
      - Node - Not started
  - **Token Plugin**
    - Support for 20.04 is mostly complete.
    - Testing is being held up by the upgrade of libsovtoken. Issues with dependencies
    - Updates to Indy Test Automation where also required.

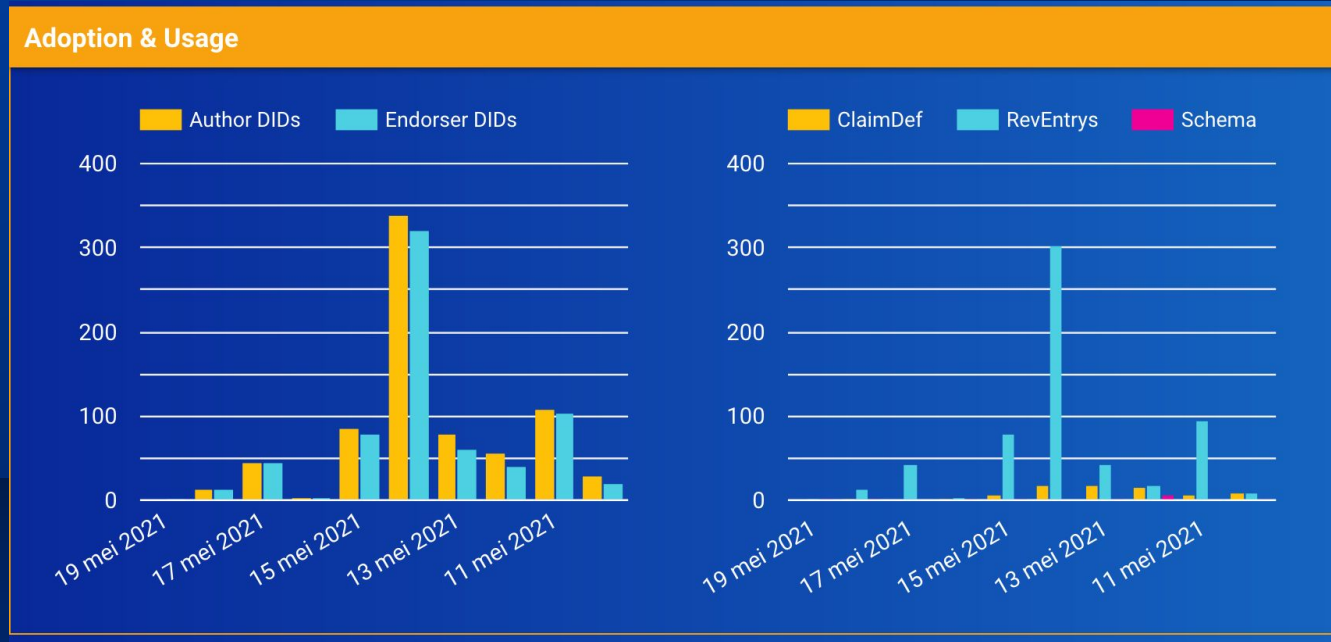

- How is the ledger being used?



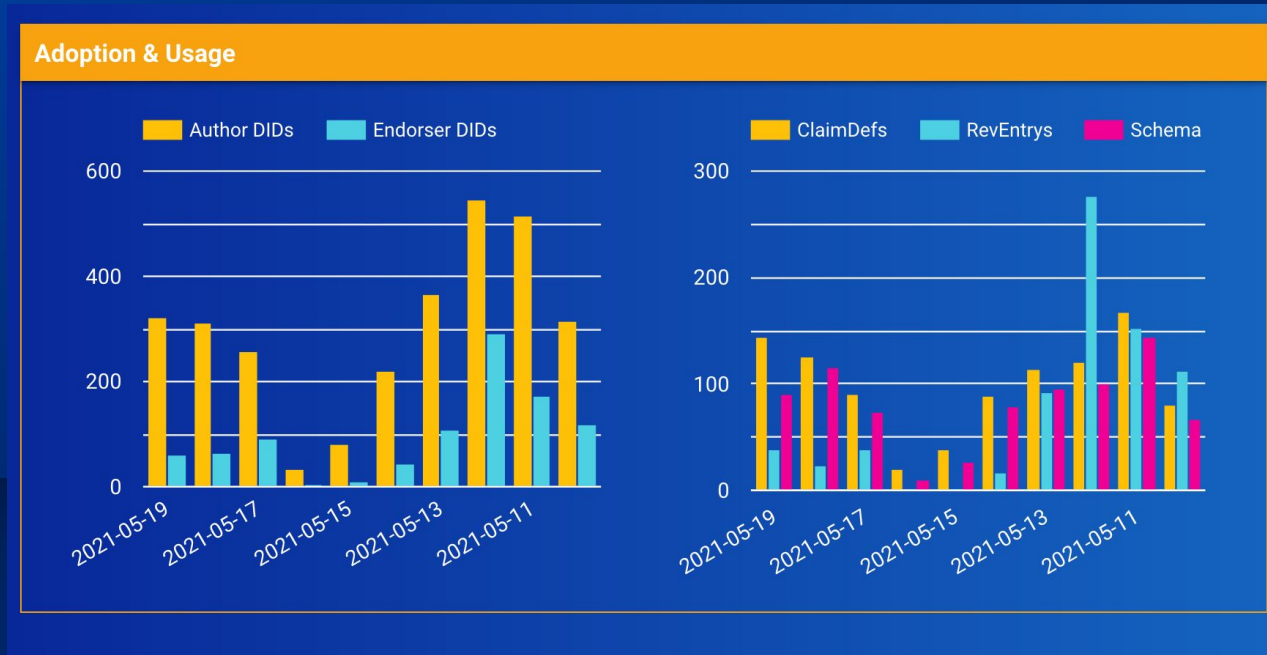

- Usage on live



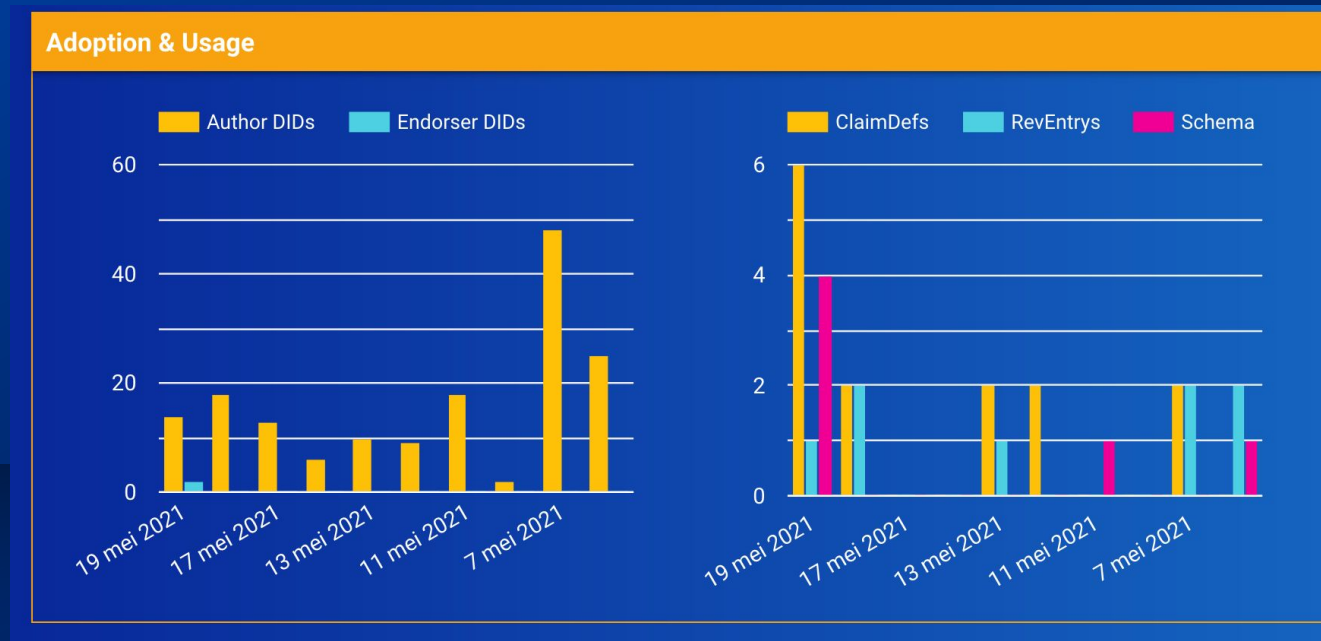

- Usage on staging



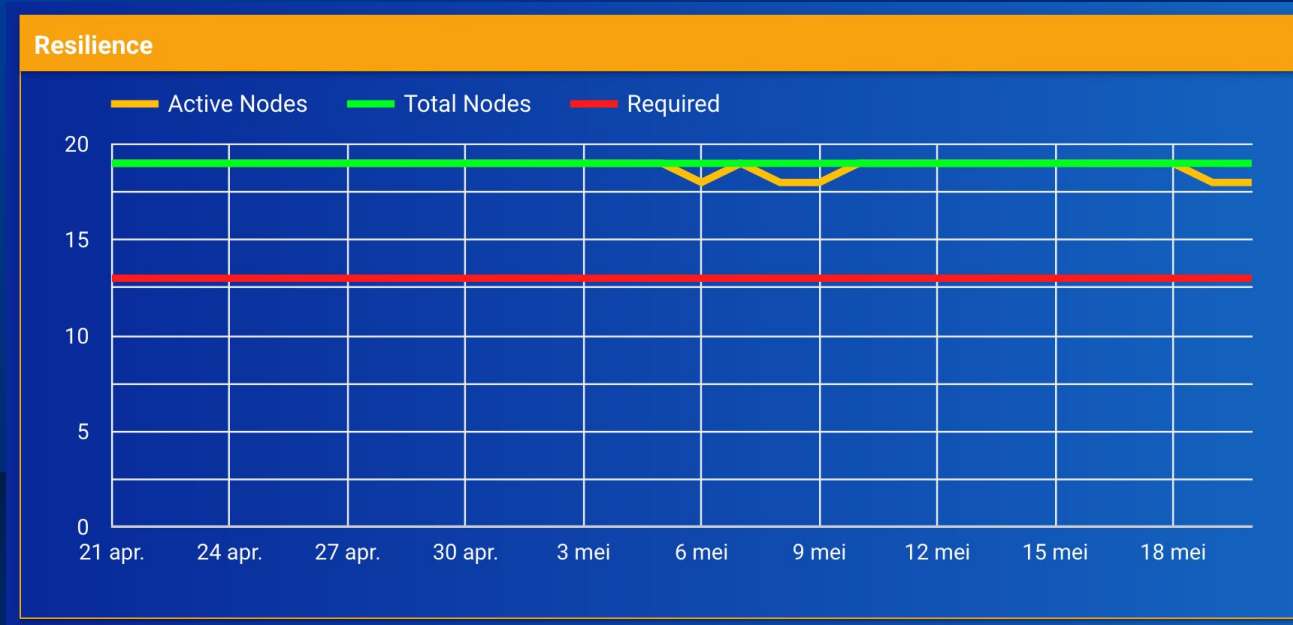
