  - Starting to investigate the <u>Node Selection Algorithm SIP</u>, and <u>Draft Propose</u> for Rewarding Validators via Proof of Contribution to Consensus concepts more.

## **Workstream 2: Technical**

#### • Node and Plenum - Ubuntu 20.04 upgrade work is ongoing.

- Robin Klemens completed the first pass of CD publishing into the new Hyperledger Debian repository (supporting 16.04 builds only).
- Release artifacts are migrating to <u>Hyperledger Artifactory</u>.
- Integration of GHA CI/CD processes into the 20.04 upgrade branches:
  - Plenum CI in progress, CD not started; summary <u>here</u>.
  - Node Not started

#### • <u>Token Plugin</u>

- Support for 20.04 is mostly complete.
- Testing is being held up by the upgrade of libsovtoken. Issues with dependencies




• How is the ledger being used?





#### • Usage on staging




