Everything You Wanted to Know about being an RN Test Observer

But were afraid to ask.....

Welcome

Being an RN Test Observer is a part-time, self schedule position.

You give us your availability, we keep you as busy as you like. We test 7 days a week, days and evenings, it is up to the test site availability.

We have regional testing for anyone in the area and closed testing to the candidates of that training program only.

You are an independent contractor. You will receive a 1099 at the end of the year. Keep all of your receipts to deduct on your taxes. You need to find an actor and a knowledge test proctor.

Three Person Test Team and Can You Believe You Get Paid for ALL THIS FUN?????

You get paid per candidate tested (per the 1505 contract in the state you conduct testing in).

You pay an actor to lie in the bed and have the skills done to them. You also pay a KTP to proctor the knowledge test. (Note: I pay my Actor \$40 cash per 4 hour event and my KTP \$20 cash because they are only there 2 hours per 8 candidates.)

Since the pandemic, some states have altered the testing models and allowed virtual knowledge testing, in those instances, you would only need one person to be the actor and you would conduct only the skills portion of the exam.

Role of the RN Test Observer (We only Contract with Nice people)

RN Test Observers are to be positive, confident, completely unbiased and professional in their words, actions and appearance.

RN Test Observers will remain impartial during testing.

RN Test Observers must give their complete and full attention to the candidate while the candidate is demonstrating her/his tasks.

RN Test Observers are to set up a testing environment that will give each candidate a fair, unbiased, equal opportunity to demonstrate s(he) knows how to perform the tasks.

RN Test Observers will recheck each candidate's ID as they enter the testing room to ensure s(he) has the correct candidate's skill test up on her/his computer/tablet/laptop screen.










You observe and record each skill test through our TMU© Software (you will just go to a website) and the checklist for each skill is all right there for you to say YES they did the skill step or NO they did not.



AMBULATION FROM BED TO WHEELCHAIR USING A GAIT BELT Perform hand hygiene. a. Cover all surfaces of hands with hand sanitizer. b. Rub hands together until hands are completely dry. Explain the procedure to the resident. Obtain gait belt for the resident. Lock bed brakes to ensure resident's safety. Adjust bed height so the resident's feet will rest comfortably flat on the floor when sitting on the bed. Bring resident to sitting position with resident's feet flat on the floor. Properly place gait belt around resident's waist. Tighten gait belt. Check gait belt for tightness by slipping fingers between gait belt and resident. Assist resident to put on non-skid footwear BEFORE standing. Bring resident to standing position. Use proper body mechanics at all times. Grasp gait belt. Stabilize resident. Ambulate resident at least 10 steps to the wheelchair. Lock wheelchair brakes to ensure resident's safety. Assist resident to pivot/turn. Sit resident in the wheelchair. Sit resident in a controlled manner. Ensure safety at all times. Remove gait belt. Place resident within easy reach of call light or signaling device. Place call light or signal device within easy reach of the resident Perform hand hygiene. a. Cover all surfaces of hands with hand sanitizer. b. Rub hands together until hands are completely dry.

First Step Qualifications

Nurse aide training programs are governed by D&SDT-Headmaster's Contract with the state agency which includes Federal law and state code.

Some states vary in the requirements of the RN Test Observer role, but at a minimum the RN must have at least two years of experience as an RN, which must include 1 year of long term care experience or care of the chronically ill.

In order to qualify, you would want to submit your:

Resume and **RN license** verification to practice in the state you will observe in. You can run yourself through Nursys to identify which states you are eligible to work in as an RN.

Next Steps -Paperwork <u>1500IC</u>

Our company can only contract with business entities. If you already have an LLC or other Business Entity...

You will just need to complete the new **1505IC and other 1500IC series forms** with your business name, FEIN and state ID number from your articles of organization with your state.

And

A NEW IRS W-9 FORM

If you do NOT have a Business...

Welcome to the wonderful world of Nurse Entrepreneurship where you can create your own destiny...

You will create a business (typically an LLC) through your state's appropriate department and request an FEIN number - federal tax ID number.

You can choose the name of your business.

After you receive your state assigned business number and FEIN number, complete the new 1505IC and 1500IC series of forms and a new W-9 found <u>here</u>.

Virtual Training Sessions

After your paperwork is complete, you will receive an RN training guide and final exam to complete (a study guide on the policies of being an RN Test Observer).

Sara will conduct virtual training sessions demonstrating live test events through TMU^{\odot} and share videos of mock live test events.

Train at Live Test Events

After the completion of virtual training, you will be given the opportunity to shadow an RN at a live test event. This will be scheduled in conjunction with your availability and in a location close to you.
