#### Do You Know?

When is the end of the PTA fiscal year?







The fiscal year of a PTA runs from July 1-June 30.

There are many things PTAs can do to get ready for the end of year transition between fiscal year and new officers.





#### **End of Fiscal Year Tasks**

- Complete all payments by June 30
  - Includes all reimbursements, bills, etc.
- Create an End of Year financial report to be presented to Board Members at the last Board meeting of the year
  - This will be used in conducting the financial review that happens during the summer
- Organize all financial materials and records to be passed along to the next officer.





#### **Materials to be Transferred:**

- All bank documents and statements, financial reports, audit reports, debit card, check book, etc.
- A copy of all meeting minutes, insurance information, bylaws, and any other documentation
- Any PTA items- tablecloth, stripe reader, etc.





#### Other End-of-Year Tasks

#### **Host End-of-Year General Membership Meeting**

- Wrap up the year
- Get a jump start on the next year- present budget for next year
- Elect your new officers

#### Finalize all Good Standing Requirements for 2023-2024 in Givebacks

- Confirm all dues have been paid
- Mark Form 990 as completed
- Mark Financial Review as completed
- Enter 2024-2025 officers' information





#### Other End-of-Year Tasks

#### **Thank Your PTA Community and Celebrate!**

- Take a moment to recognize and thank all those who have helped make this PTA year successful
- Celebrate and highlight all that your PTA has accomplished this year
- Host a volunteer celebration, send a thank you note or email, etc.





#### Tasks to be Completed after July 1

- Financial Review- Your audit committee should conduct an End of Year financial review, compiling all their documents from the year and the final treasurer report
  - This should be completed and submitted to Givebacks by August 31
- Submit form 990 for taxes- Once your financial year is completed you can submit your taxes with the IRS.
  - This needs to be completed and submitted to Givebacks by the IRS deadline of November 15





#### **Financial Review**

#### **Audit Committee conducts the Financial Review**

- Should be done after all financial business for the 2023-2024 year is done (on or before June 30, 2024) and before any spending takes place for 2024-2025
- This is a Good Standing requirement and needs to be marked completed in Givebacks under the 2024-2025 compliance tab
- Guidance on completing a financial review can be found on <u>our website</u>





#### **Form 990**

Taxes need to be filed with the IRS annually through filing the Form 990

- Units making under \$50,000- Form 990N postcard
- Units making under \$200,000- Form 990 EZ
- Units making more than \$200,000- Form 990

Form 990 can be filed after July 1 of the new fiscal year, but needs to be filed by November 15 in accordance with the IRS.

Filing on time is important as it prevents penalties with the IRS. Not filing for 3 years results in IRS Revocation, a \$275 fee with the IRS

#### **Important Meeting Notes**

- Your PTA Board should meet once a month
- Your General Membership should meet at least 3 times per year

Schedule these meetings during your calendar planning.





#### **Gathering Your PTA Materials**

- July 1, 2024 is your first official day as a PTA officer for the 2024-2025 school year
- Once you have your officer materials passed on from the 2023-2024 officers, take some time to familiarize yourself with them and take note of all you need for this upcoming school year





#### Schedule Your First Board Meeting/Retreat

- Your first board meeting needs to be hosted during the summer; a half or full day retreat is a great strategy
- Come together to learn more about each other, establish goals for the year, and to plan your calendar of events for the year





#### **Budgets**

- If your former PTA board did not plan and get approved a budget for the 2024-2025 school year, this needs to be planned right away and voted at during your first general membership meeting of the year
- If your former PTA board planned and got approved a budget, any change to the budget will need to be voted on during a general membership meeting





#### **Calendar of Events**

Planning your year is an important task for any PTA board. It helps focus your unit on the mission and goal of your PTA for the year.




