

- Students and parents will be provided resources to ensure they can effectively navigate and access information on Google Classroom and our new PK-4 platform: Seesaw.




### **Health Office**

- You must be certain to have all necessary medical documentation on file with our School Nurse.
- All students new to Acelero Learning must have a complete immunization record and physical on file in order to begin virtual instruction.
  - If your child is not compliant with these requirements they will not be given access to virtual instruction until they are cleared by our school nurse.
