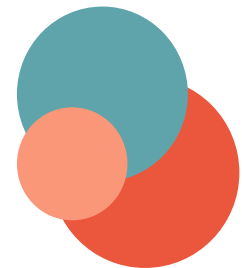

What is School Improvement

The purpose of school improvement is to improve achievement and outcomes for every student by working to eliminate the ability to predict achievement based on socioeconomic status, race, and ethnicity.

We do this by collaboratively and continuously analyzing data and making decisions considering the unique needs of the learning community and the district's strategic plan.

Every school has a specialized plan and SMART Goals using their own data, needs and focuses. All committee action items should be tied to SIP Indicators and should also correlate with student academic and overall success.



NEW School Improvement Goals

Academic SMART Goal

By June 2025, East Garner Elementary School will meet or exceed growth as measured by EVAAS data. Overall proficiency will increase from 40% to 60%, and the proficiency of underperforming subgroups will increase by an average of 10% percentage points as measured by the NC EOG.

Climate SMART Goal

By the end of 2025, EGES staff will increase perception data of construct Q 7.1, Teachers feel comfortable raising issues and concerns that are important to them from 63% to 75%, as evidence by the Teacher Working Conditions Survey in 2024 and in house surveys in 2023 & 2025.

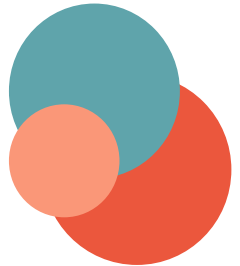

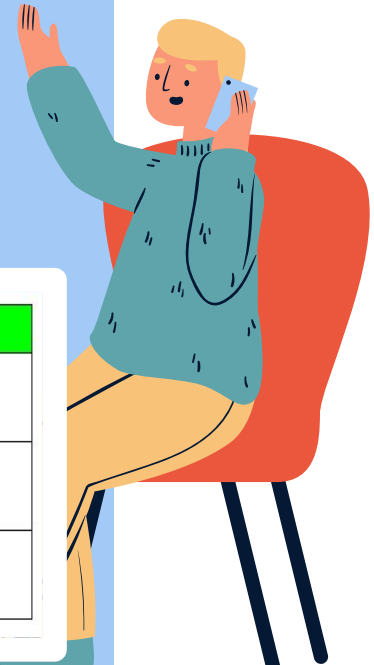
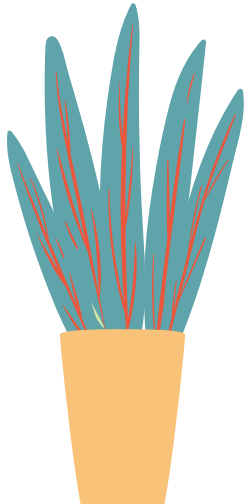
