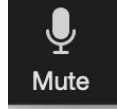
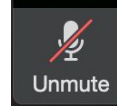

# Paragraphs

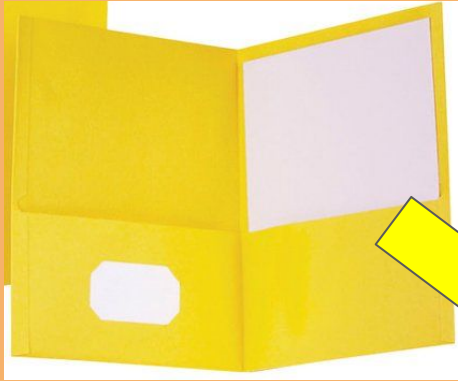
A paragraph is a group of sentences about one **topic**.
