- an input device used to substitute for or complement a mouse
- used in conjunction with an existing device



- digital sketchnoting
- digitizing the analog note-taking process
- digital sketching in Art & Design courses





DIGITIZING THE ANALOG NOTETAKING PROCESS

Studies have shown that students who take notes on a computer retain less information and are less able to synthesize and generalize information than those who take notes by hand.

A Wacom Pen Tablet makes it possible to write longhand notes, but store them digitally.



BAMBOO SPARK

- draw on paper; transfer notes & images to connected tablet with the touch of a button
- requires a bluetooth connection to an iPad or Android tablet device with the Bamboo Paper app installed
- can store up to 100 pages of content before uploading to external device



INTUOS ART, PT MEDIUM

- draw on tablet surface while connected to computer; images and pen strokes transfer instantaneously to screen
- pressure-sensitive pen



INTUOS PRO PEN & TOUCH

- draw on tablet surface while connected to computer; images and pen strokes transfer instantaneously to screen
- pressure -sensitive pen for accuracy, precision and variability
- multi-touch gesture support
