Look at Dylan.



Dylan isn't playing a computer game.

I'm not meeting my friends.

Tina and Zack / not go to the cinema



Tina and Zack aren't going to the cinema.

Look at mum



Mum isn't cleaning the window.

Look at Jake



Jake isn't climbing a tree.
