Action


Organizations should comment in Allocator-Governance Issue 6 with their timeline for onboarding pathway or start allocating data.




Organizations will begin receiving next rounds of DataCap refresh from the Root Key Holders.

Please see your open diligence review for action or comments needed.




Organizations received a comment in the Allocator-Governance repo with comment indicating refresh grant and required diligence requirements.

Allocator Applications

- Initial or reapplying



Apply (or re-apply)

If an Organization wishes to apply or reapply to become an Allocator, there is now a rolling application process.

No longer need to wait until an open election period.

Detailed guide posted to the FIDL blog.

1. Create a Pull Request:

- Visit the Allocator Governance GitHub page.
- Create a new pull request by adding a new file to the repository.
- o This file can be empty; just name it appropriately, like "Allocator application".
- o Commit the change and add it as a branch, then click "Create pull request".

2. Access Your Application Form:

- Wait for about a minute. A comment will appear with a link to the airtable, which serves as your actual
 application form.
- o Open this link in a new tab for easy access.

3. Fill Out Your Details:

- Ensure you have your GitHub ID and the pull request number handy.
- Complete the form with the required information. At the end, you'll find a section for your contact details. Rest
 assured, this information is solely for KYC purposes and won't be published.

4. Confirm Your Submission:

- After submitting the form, return to GitHub to find an issue created on your behalf with all your application details.
- Check the allocator registry GitHub for a new issue requesting to add you to the JSON file used by the governance team. This will also generate a pull request for easy merging.

5. Receive Confirmation:

If you provided your email address, you'll receive a confirmation email with the details you submitted. This
allows us to contact you quickly if there are any issues with your application.



RFA Request for Allocators

- FIDL and Gov Team started list of allocator requests
- Identify onboarding pathways and opportunities
- Seeking community contributions
- Prioritizing these pathways over redundant allocator types for now

Spark Retrieval

Should be >85%

- Process
 - IPNI to find cids
 within data that
 has been indexed.
 - Attempt to
 download and
 report aggregate
 success rate.

- SPs actions
 - Publish index toIPNI
 - Retrieval overHTTP (e.g.booster-http)
 - Public, non IP filtered access



- Metric
 - Of different retrieval attempts to miner/actor.
 - What % was successfully download.



LDN Requests

- The LDN pathway has been sunset
- All DataCap is now managed individually be each Allocator
 - VS a shared community pool in the LDN model
- FIDL has developed tooling and a public open data application.

Have a Open Data or Private Data project that needs DataCap?

- First time users can get up to 50TiBs and make deals to build a reputation
- Trusted users can then apply for larger amounts of DataCap allocated over 4 segments
