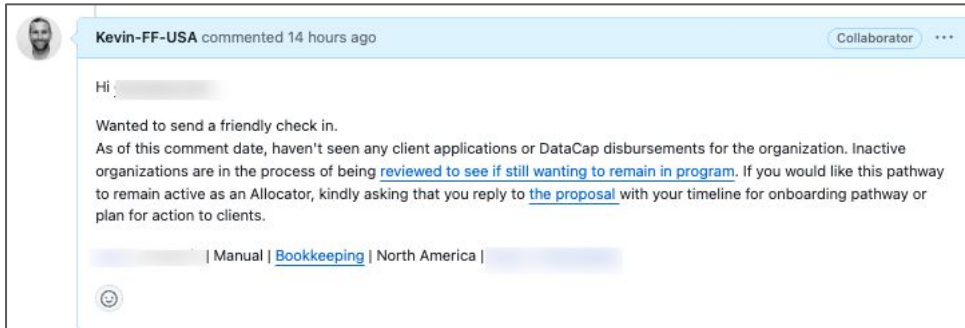
**If no response, organization will remain in the Allocator comms, but have their DataCap rescinded and have to reapply in order to receive an initial allocation.**

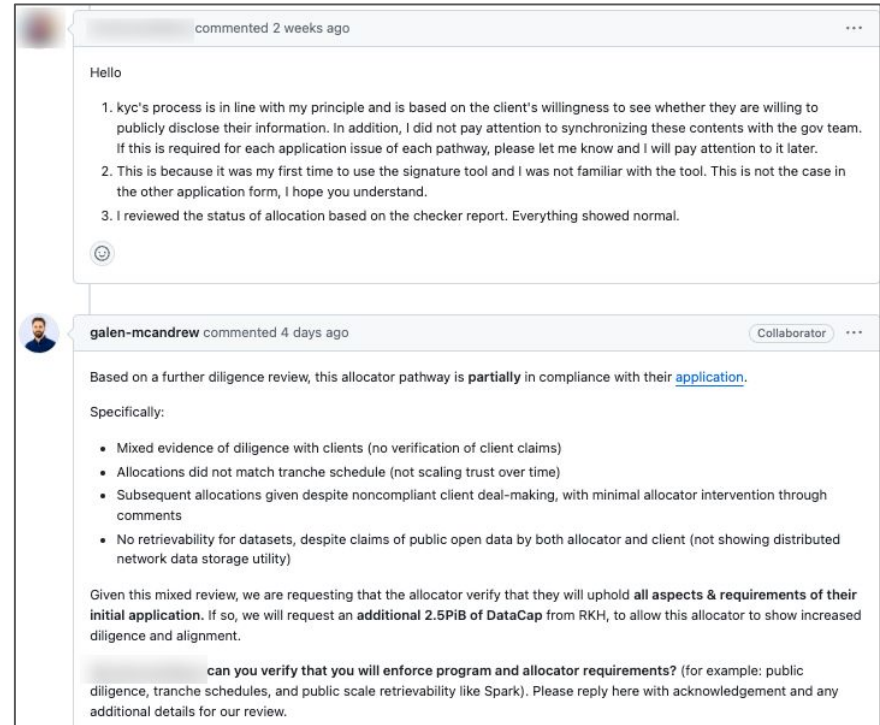

# DataCap Refresh

Organizations received a comment in the Allocator-Governance repo with comment indicating refresh grant and required diligence requirements.



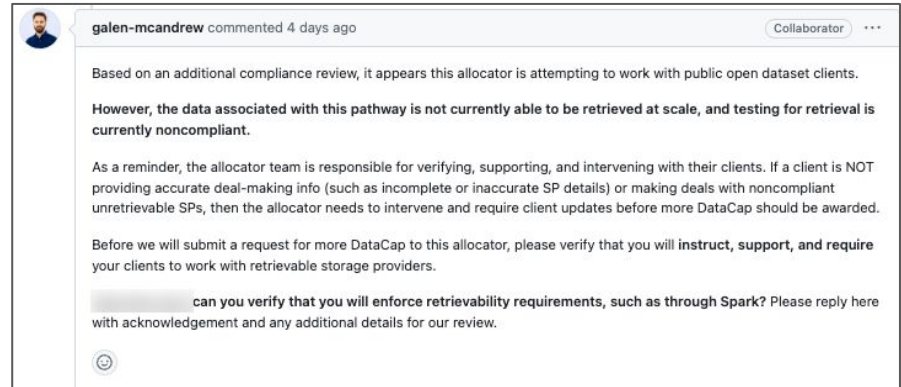
The screenshot shows two comments from a GitHub issue. The first comment, from a user who commented 2 weeks ago, says "Hello" and lists three points: 1. kyc's process is in line with my principle and is based on the client's willingness to see whether they are willing to publicly disclose their information. In addition, I did not pay attention to synchronizing these contents with the gov team. If this is required for each application issue of each pathway, please let me know and I will pay attention to it later. 2. This is because it was my first time to use the signature tool and I was not familiar with the tool. This is not the case in the other application form, I hope you understand. 3. I reviewed the status of allocation based on the checker report. Everything showed normal.

The second comment, from galen-mcandrew who commented 4 days ago and is a collaborator, states: "Based on a further diligence review, this allocator pathway is **partially** in compliance with their [application](#)." It then lists specific issues: "Specifically: • Mixed evidence of diligence with clients (no verification of client claims) • Allocations did not match tranche schedule (not scaling trust over time) • Subsequent allocations given despite noncompliant client deal-making, with minimal allocator intervention through comments • No retrievability for datasets, despite claims of public open data by both allocator and client (not showing distributed network data storage utility)". It concludes: "Given this mixed review, we are requesting that the allocator verify that they will uphold **all aspects & requirements of their initial application**. If so, we will request an **additional 2.5PiB of DataCap** from RKH, to allow this allocator to show increased diligence and alignment." It ends with a question: "can you verify that you will enforce program and allocator requirements? (for example: public diligence, tranche schedules, and public scale retrievability like Spark). Please reply here with acknowledgement and any additional details for our review."

# Apply (or re-apply)

**If an Organization wishes to apply or reapply to become an Allocator, there is now a rolling application process.**

**No longer need to wait until an open election period.**

## 1. Create a Pull Request:

- Visit the Allocator Governance GitHub page.
- Create a new pull request by adding a new file to the repository.
- This file can be empty; just name it appropriately, like "Allocator application".
- Commit the change and add it as a branch, then click "Create pull request".

## 2. Access Your Application Form:

- Wait for about a minute. A comment will appear with a link to the airtable, which serves as your actual application form.
- Open this link in a new tab for easy access.

## 3. Fill Out Your Details:

- Ensure you have your GitHub ID and the pull request number handy.
- Complete the form with the required information. At the end, you'll find a section for your contact details. Rest assured, this information is solely for KYC purposes and won't be published.

## 4. Confirm Your Submission:

- After submitting the form, return to GitHub to find an issue created on your behalf with all your application details.
- Check the allocator registry GitHub for a new issue requesting to add you to the JSON file used by the governance team. This will also generate a pull request for easy merging.

## 5. Receive Confirmation:

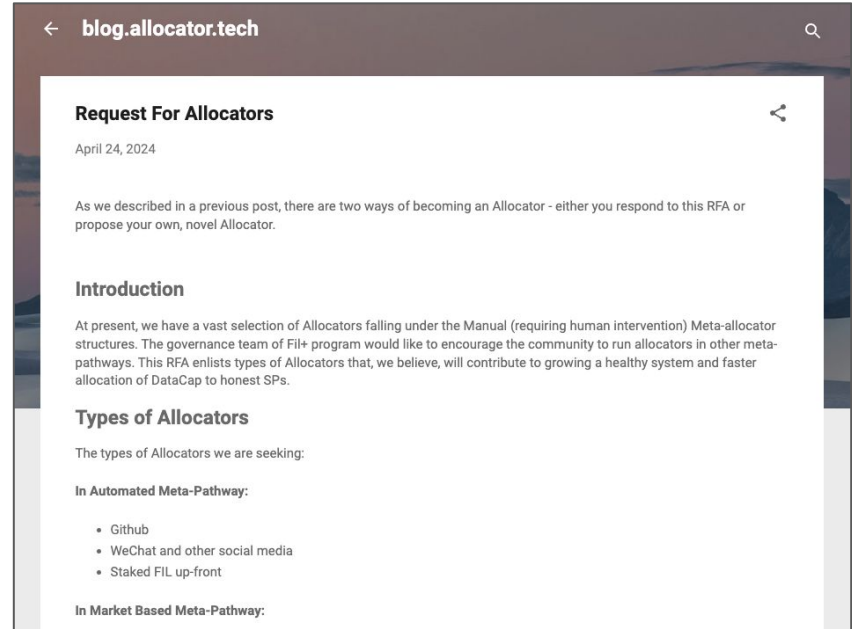
- If you provided your email address, you'll receive a confirmation email with the details you submitted. This allows us to contact you quickly if there are any issues with your application.

# Spark Retrieval

Should be >85%

| Miners Performance |                |                         |

- **Process**

- IPNI to find cids within data that has been indexed.
- Attempt to download and report aggregate success rate.

- **SPs actions**

- Publish index to IPNI
- Retrieval over HTTP (e.g. booster-http)
- Public, non IP filtered access

- **Metric**

- Of different retrieval attempts to miner/actor.
- What % was successfully download.

# LDN Requests

- The LDN pathway has been sunset
- All DataCap is now managed individually by each Allocator
  - VS a shared community pool in the LDN model
- FIDL has developed tooling and a public open data application.

## Have a Open Data or Private Data project that needs DataCap?

- First time users can get up to 50TiBs and make deals to build a reputation
- Trusted users can then apply for larger amounts of DataCap allocated over 4 segments

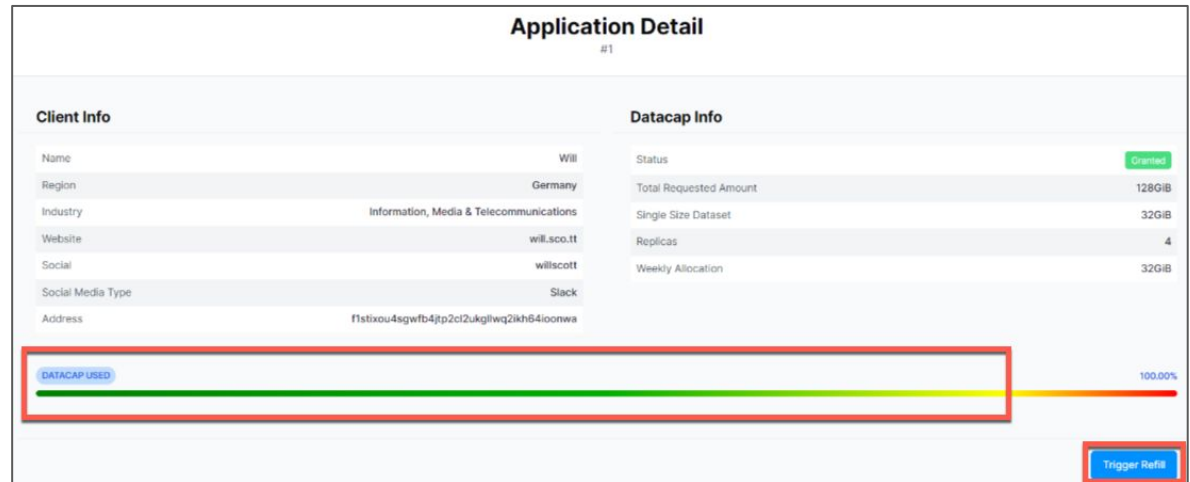
