### **Selecting Subjects**

After you have logged in, the first screen asks you to select your intentions for next year. Use the dropdown menu to make your selection. This has to be completed before you can continue.

### **Selecting Subjects - My Details**

The next screen will be 'My Details'. This is where you enter your personal details: personal email address; mobile number; etc. Once you have completed this you can select 'Course for Me' on the sidebar





### **Selecting Subjects**

When you select 'Courses for Me', this will show the courses available, at your Year level, for 2024.

For example, if you were going into Year 13 in 2024, your screen will look like this:

### **Selecting Subjects - Compulsory subjects**

Before you can select your option subjects, you have to select your compulsory subjects. You will see the subjects that will automatically be assigned to you in a light grey (for example Religious Studies). The compulsory subjects will show up on the side, for example Mathematics (Compulsory).





### **Selecting Subjects - Compulsory subjects**

Click on one of the compulsory subjects. A new page will open with the options to select from. For example, in Year 11, Science has two options. Select one of them. This will open a new page where you can '+Select as one of my Courses' the Science option you wish to be enrolled in. Repeat for any other compulsory subjects. Once this has been done, you will be able to choose your optional subjects.

### Selecting a Subject - Optional Subjects

When you click on a subject, the following buttons will show at the top.

If you know it is a subject you definitely want to do, click the '+ Select as one of my Courses'

If you are still considering this option then you can 'Add it to your Favourite Courses' and refer back to it before deciding on your final selection. A yellow star will appear on any subjects you have added to your Favourites





### Selecting a Subject - Backup Subject

This year all students can select a Backup Subject.

This subject **must** be the last one you select.

Once you have selected all of your compulsory and optional subjects, you can select your backup subject. Once you have selected your backup subject, click the '+ Select as my Backup Course'.





# Selecting a Subject - making changes to your main selection

If you decide to make a subject change to your main selection, click on the subject you wish to change. Click on the 'X Remove from my options', then click on '-Confirm Delete'. This will remove that subject from your selection. Click on the 'View Course for Me' button (blue button) and this will take you back to the previous page. Choose your new subject, click on '+Select as one of my Courses'.



# Selecting a Subject - making changes to your backup selection

If you decide to make a subject change to your backup selection, click on the subject you wish to change. Click on the 'X Remove from my options', then click on '-Confirm Delete'. This will remove that subject from your selection. Click on the 'View Course for Me' button (blue button) and this will take you back to the previous page. Choose your new subject, click on '+Select as my Backup Course'. Just make sure that you do have the correct subject showing as your backup, and you didn't remove one of your main subjects in error.



## **Selecting your Subjects - Confirming your subjects**

When you have made all your selections, click on the 'View Select Courses'

button.





### **Selecting your Subjects - Confirming your subjects**

On this page you can select your subject priority order. This will let us know which of your subjects are the most important to you and, if possible, would not have to be swapped out for your backup subject in case of clashes to the timetable, limited

class sizing, etc.





### **Selecting your Subjects - Subject Priority Order**

Click on the 'Select Course Priority Order' button.

You will see Religious Studies is automatically at the top with a light grey box beside it. This subject can not be moved.

The next subjects will be your compulsory subjects, followed by your optional subjects.

To move them, just click and hold the *button at the side of the subject name, and drag to where you would like it to be.* 

Click the 'Save Course Priority Order'



### **Selecting Subjects - Confirming choices**

Once you have finished selecting your subjects, when you click on 'View Selected Courses' it will give you the screen below for you to finalise your course selection by clicking on 'Complete My Courses'.

### Year 12 going into Year 13 in 2024

There is **ONE** compulsory subject: Religious Education When you log in, you will see that Religious Education has automatically been added to your subject list.

You also need to select **FIVE** optional subjects One of these subjects can be ILT (Independent Learning).



## Year 11 going into Year 12 in 2024

There are **TWO** compulsory subjects: Religious Education English When you log in, you will see that Religious Education and English have automatically been added to your subject list.

You also need to select **FIVE** optional subjects One of these subjects can be ILT (Independent Learning).



## Year 10 going into Year 11 in 2024

There are **FOUR** compulsory subjects:

Religious Education English OR English as an Additional Language Mathematics Science OR Science Applied When you log in, you will see that Religious Education has automatically been added to your subject list but you will need to select which version of Mathematics, Science and English you wish to take.

You also need to select **THREE** optional subjects One of these subjects can be ILT (Independent Learning).



## Year 10 going into Year 11 in 2024

We are in the process of planning for the implementation of NCEA Level 1, 2024. At this point in time the revised Achievement Standards are in draft. Once the Achievement Standards are registered, learning areas will determine what standards will be assessed in 2024.

This information will be shared when it becomes available, which could be as late as the start of the 2024 academic year.

The literacy and numeracy co-requisite will be assessed in 2023 for Year 10 students as we are piloting these standards. Further information regarding the sitting of the co-requisites for Year 10 students will be communicated shortly
