Math

GoMath- Place Value, decimals, fractions, conversion of measurement, and geometry.

* Students must know their multiplication facts in order to be successful in 5th grade math.

ELA

Wonders-Comprehension, vocabulary, spelling and writing.

Amplify- Hands on, project-based learning.

Social Studies

TCI- Focusing on the Revolutionary War, states, capitals, and locations.





INTERVENTION

Math & Reading UA

- Focusing on instruction at the student's individual need.
- Ensures every student is given the opportunity to be successful.
- Using assessments and observations to determine areas to work on.
- Working in small groups for reteach and enrichment opportunities.











CLASSROOM

- Focusing on positive behaviors.
- When students are being respectful, responsible, or safe, they can earn PBIS points that can be used to shop at the PBIS store each month.
- Team points Holding each other accountable.
- For negative behaviors I will work with them in class to address the behaviors. If they are recurring I will be letting the student know their parent/guardian will be contacted. Friday Folders will go home with work habits/behaviors for the week.



HOMEWORK

Reading - 20 minutes of nightly reading with a summary on their reading log.

Math - Daily math page that goes with the lesson learned in class that day.

<u>Vocabulary/Spelling</u> - Either daily vocabulary activity OR spelling.

* Homework should take no more than an hour



GRADING

- Updated in Aeries weekly.
- Don't worry if at the beginning of the trimester it seems like your child isn't doing well. It's because there aren't a lot of grades in there yet.
- GFA's (Grade First Aid) will be available for any student who would like to fix a grade on a math test/quiz. They would need to identify their mistakes and correct the problems to bring their grade up to a 70%.






