

Connecting To Your Synchronous Session

Tips for Successful Participation



Download the Software

<u>Downloading the software</u> or <u>updating</u> it helps ensure you can use all of the functionality (like breakout groups and polling).

This will also help you understand when you need to update the software to ensure you can fully participate.





Hardwired Connection

An ethernet connection is the best way to ensure you get the best experience.

If you're unable to use a ethernet cable, test out your WiFi connection to make sure it's strong enough for a smooth synchronous session experience.





Quiet Setting

You will need to participate and engage in a video conference.

Find a space that is distraction free to work from!






Join Early

Join the session early!

This will ensure that you can test your settings and resolve technical issues *prior* to the beginning of the session.



Log in Using Your Full Name

Logging in using your full name helps to ensure that we know who is participating in the session.

In some instances, participation is monitored or you may be called on by the name you logged in with during the class session.






Test Settings

Test your microphone and video camera as soon as you get into the video conference. You can do this by <u>using the Zoom Test Meeting</u>.

Chat with someone if you cannot resolve your issues!





Headset with Microphone

A USB headset with a microphone will give you the best hearing and speaking experience!

You may already have earphones that come with your phone; these are typically not the best for video conferencing but will do in a pinch!






Position Your Webcam

Position your webcam so that we can see you clearly.

If you are using a separate USB webcam, make sure you select the correct webcam through the settings.







Muting your mic when you're not speaking reduces background noise that gets carried through the mic.

This will create a better listening experience for both you and your peers.





Recorded

This may be recorded!
