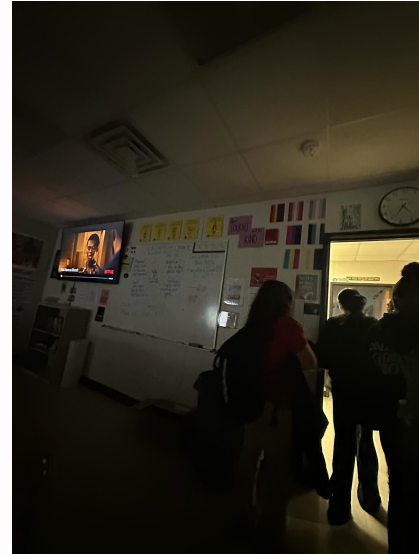
## Scholar of the Month

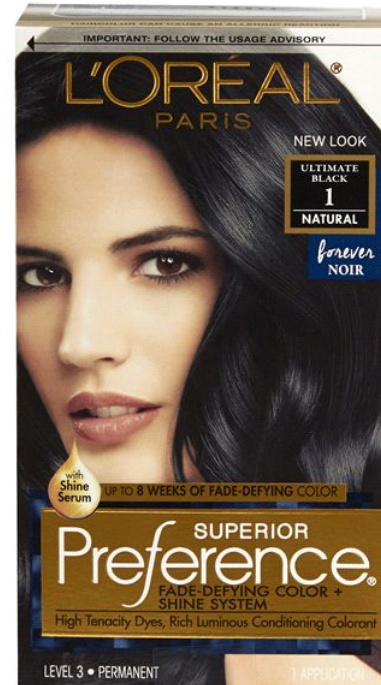

(Hair Dye)

Once a month, I use the L'oreal Paris black hair dye to dye my mom's hair. I start by preparing for the process. I first wrapped a towel around her neck and shoulders to protect her clothes. I went ahead and added concealer in her dark spots and blended it in with a damp beauty blender. After, I applied cream contour with a flat brush, then later blended it out with a fluffy brush. I applied blush the same way. I set her face and after that it was ready for mascara! Lastly, I locked the makeup in with a strong setting spray that is popular for keeping your makeup in place all day!

During this process, my client was very comfortable, and she showed me the look she was going for.
