Option 4 Whether you prefer classroom learning or online learning, and why;

Personally, I prefer classroom learning.

Why Online Education Is Less Effective Than In-Person Learning

- 4. No face-to-face contact with fellow students or course staff.
- 5. No student facilities such as laboratories or libraries Watch the next slide

Advantages of classroom learning

- · You can interact with students and teachers face -to -face. You socialize by communicating with people
- With traditional class you have to attend class every day you are scheduled and participate every day.
- · It's a time-approved method of learning
- · Computers can't replace teachers
- Learning in a class is more interactive than learning online. If you have a question you can always ask the teacher.
 It's also helpful to see how others learn things with you.

You listen to questions of others and understand the material better. (Last month all the pupils from our class discussed

some contradictory moments of Peter the Great rule. I would not have understood them without that discussion.)

Option 5 Whether schoolchildren should be given more or less homework, and why;

Homework is an essential part of our school life. When we do our homework we understand the material of the lesson better, revise and memorise it. Homework teaches us to work independently, on our own. That develops our learning skills.

In my opinion, doing school homework is necessary but it shouldn't take most of our free time.

I think that schoolchildren should be given less homework because they should have more time for their hobbies. **Besides,** it's important for students to get enough sleep and do sports.

- If a student wants to know more, he can do some additional exercises, but the amount of compulsory homework should be reasonable.
- Too much homework can kill the motivation to study because if the student is tired he loses the motivation.
- Too much homework can cause problems with your health especially connected with eyes and back.
- If you have to go to bed very late after doing your homework, you can become tired, aggressive and nervous.

Option6 What weekday you find the most difficult, and why

Example:

Option 7 Whether it is important to wear uniform at school, and why

There are two viewpoints on school uniforms.

On the one hand, some people think that it is **unnecessary** to wear a school uniform as it kills individuality.

On the other hand, there are some benefits (= advantages) of wearing a school uniform. **In my opinion**, it is necessary to wear a school uniform , because it influences our studies and behavior at school. (add 2 more arguments)

- School uniform organizes students. They concentrate more on their studies. They are not distracted from their learning process and perform (study) better. Besides, uniform improves a child's school discipline
- Uniform helps build a school spirit or a sense of belonging. Uniform unites schoolchildren and make them feel proud of being a part of their school.
- Some parents consider that it's better to buy a school uniform instead of spending money on fashionable and expensive clothes.
- School uniform doesn't allow children to express their individuality. Boys and girls have to wear the same design and colour suits. Students look consistently. It is rather boring

Your reasons to go to school

It is true to say that without being educated it is difficult to achieve good job or succeed in life. There is no doubt, that school is our second home. We spend a lot of time studying and communicating with our friends and teachers at school.

I think that the main reason to go to school is getting knowledge in different subjects. A school makes students clever and well-educated. OUR SCHOOL

My School

I go to school number 548 with in-depth study of English. My school is a three-floored redbrick building with a courtyard.

Classrooms

My school has both small and big classrooms. The large classrooms are computer ones which are used for IT lessons, gymnasiums for sports, special classrooms for Biology, Chemistry and Physics and classrooms for Primary school pupils. There are also small group classrooms where students learn in groups of about 10 or less. They are usually used for English lessons.

Most classrooms have a large writing surface where the teacher or students can share notes with other members of the class. Traditionally, this is in the form of a blackboard but we also have whiteboards and interactive whiteboards. Many classrooms also have TVs, maps, charts, books and LCD projectors for presenting information and images from a computer.

FACILITIES

Facilities

An effective school facility is responsible to the process of studying and should be comfortable, safe, secure, accessible, well illuminated, well ventilated, and aesthetically pleasing. The facility also includes furnishings, materials and supplies, equipment and information technology, as well as various aspects of the building grounds, namely, athletic fields, playgrounds, areas for outdoor learning and parking.

In our school we have a library, a canteen, an Assembly Hall, an infirmary, a stadium, a gymnasium, 2 cloakrooms, 3 computer classes and a laboratory.

SCHOOL RULES

Our classes start at 9.00 a.m. and finish at 14.30. We have 6 or 7 lessons every day. Each lesson lasts 40 minutes. Here are some general rules and regulations in my school:

- Students must wear school uniform.
- Students must not wear cosmetics and other beauty accessories.
- Students must not bring valuable items to the school. If they do, the teachers will keep such items, which will only be returned when his/her parents come and collect it/them.
- Students must use the school's equipment with care.
- Students must not leave the school without the school permission during the lessons. When leaving or entering, students must use a magnetic key.
- When in school, students must not make a loud noise.
- When using special classrooms and/or rooms, e.g. computer room, library, infirmary and so on, students must obey each room's regulations.
- Students must behave appropriately to his/her teachers, staff, friends and other people.
- Smoking, drinking and drug possession is strongly prohibited.
- Students must attend school regularly, as well as attend every subject according to his/her timetable.
- Chewing gum is not allowed
- Students must not bring food to his/her classroom.

After-school activities

There are a lot of organized after-school activities in my school. They focus on a variety of things or issues:

Sports, including football, basketball and volleyball

Performing arts like dance and choir

Creative arts, including painting, drawing and crafts such as beading

Optional classes, for example, Mathematics, Russian or English
