

Badra volunteers to help people from school. Siyoum helps people at work. He helps push wheelchairs, brings people water, and helps them find the front desk. If someone is sick or needs a ride, Fadumo cooks for them or gives them a ride. Asnaku helps new people find the Welfare Department and DSHS. She gives them food. She helps new people go to the store and the bus, and she listens to them.
