Kentucky's state flower is called a goldenrod

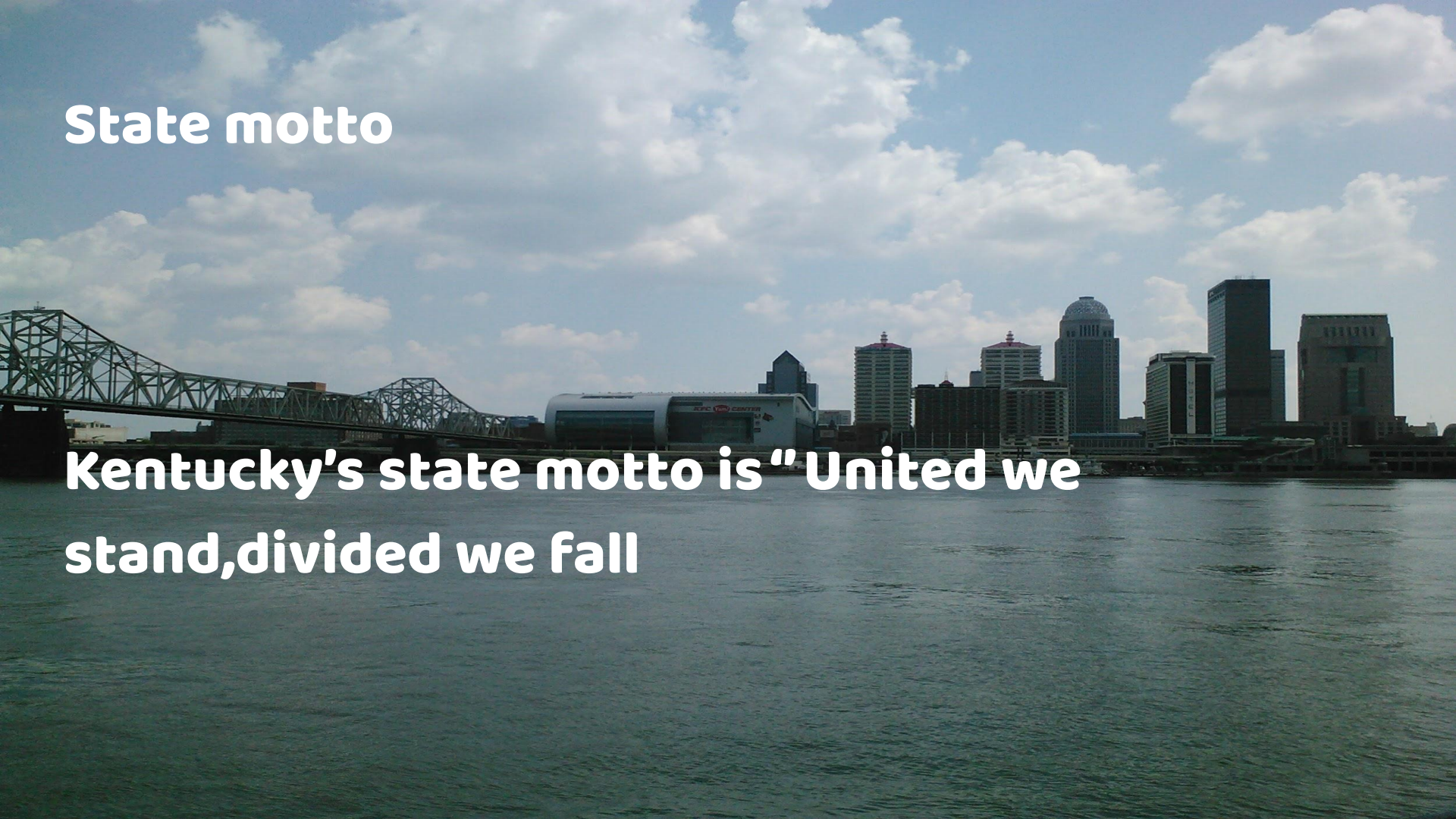
State bird

State berry




Kentucky's state berry is a blackberry

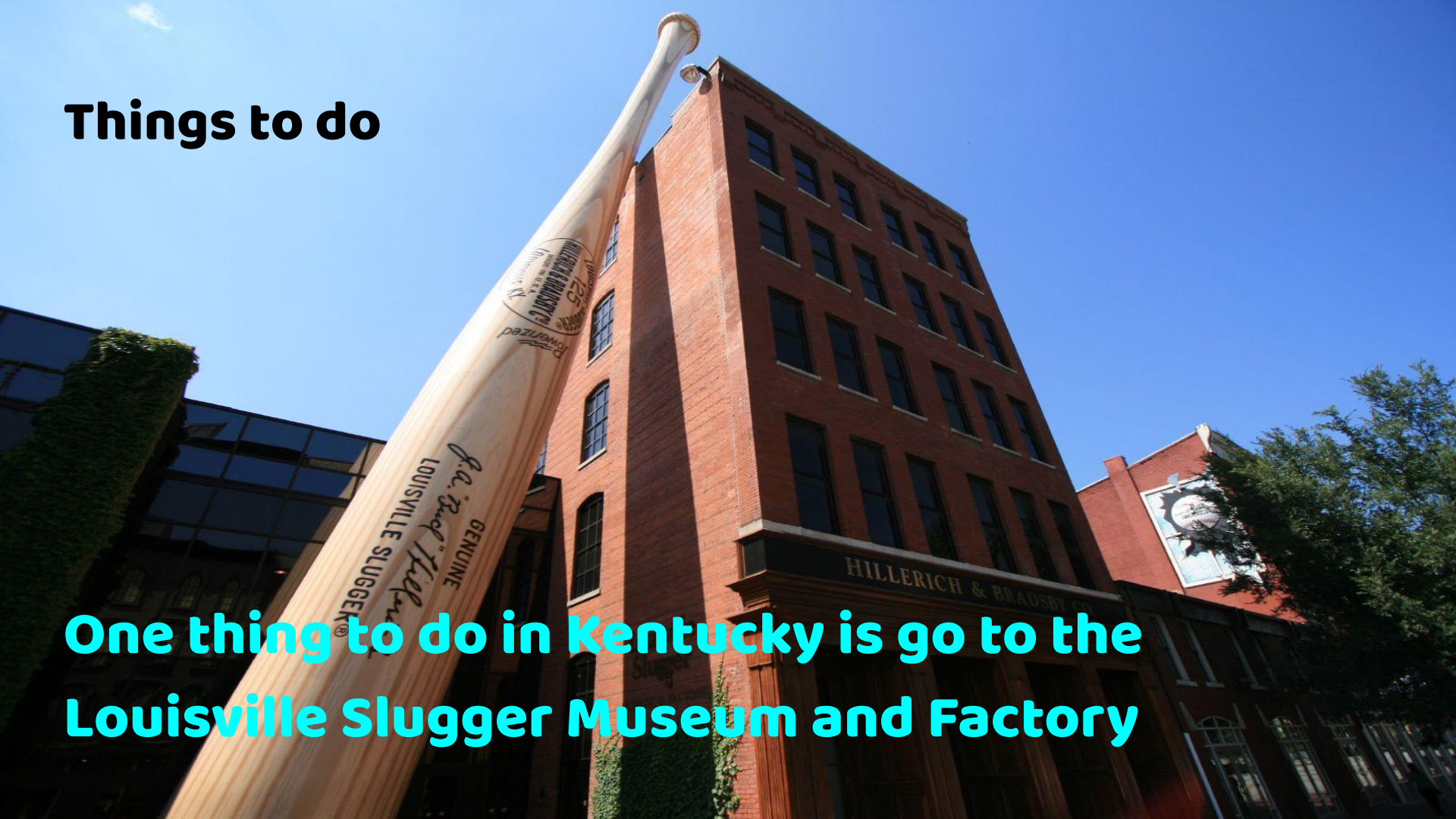
**The bordering states of Kentucky are: Ohio, Indiana, Illinois,
