What is *crime*?

Crime = When somebody does something *illegal*.

What is a *criminal*?

Police don't say "do a crime".

Police say "commit a crime."

So what's another way to say

Yes, I believe it is.

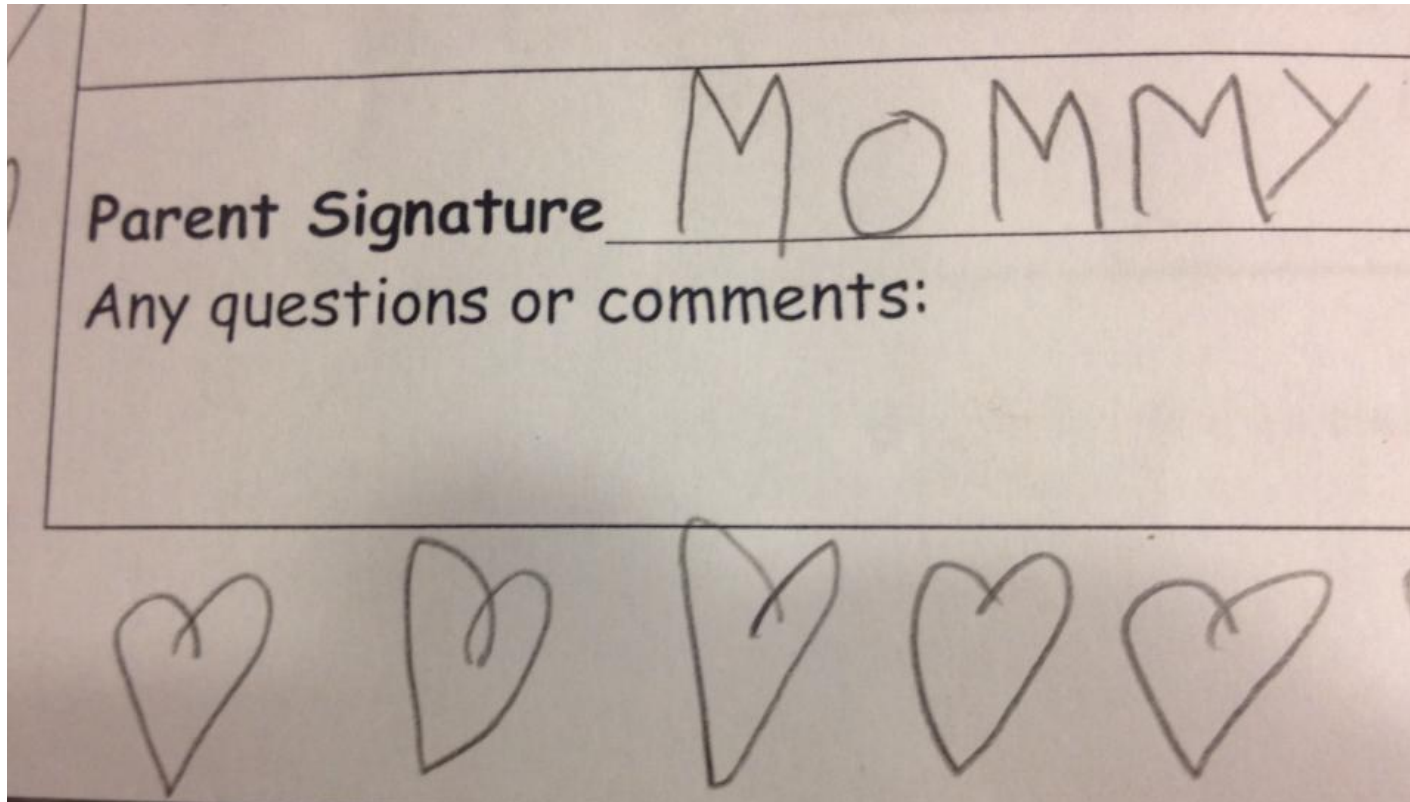


What kind of

What's that?

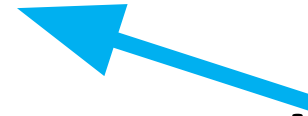
That's a *knight stick*.

Do you have a lawyer?

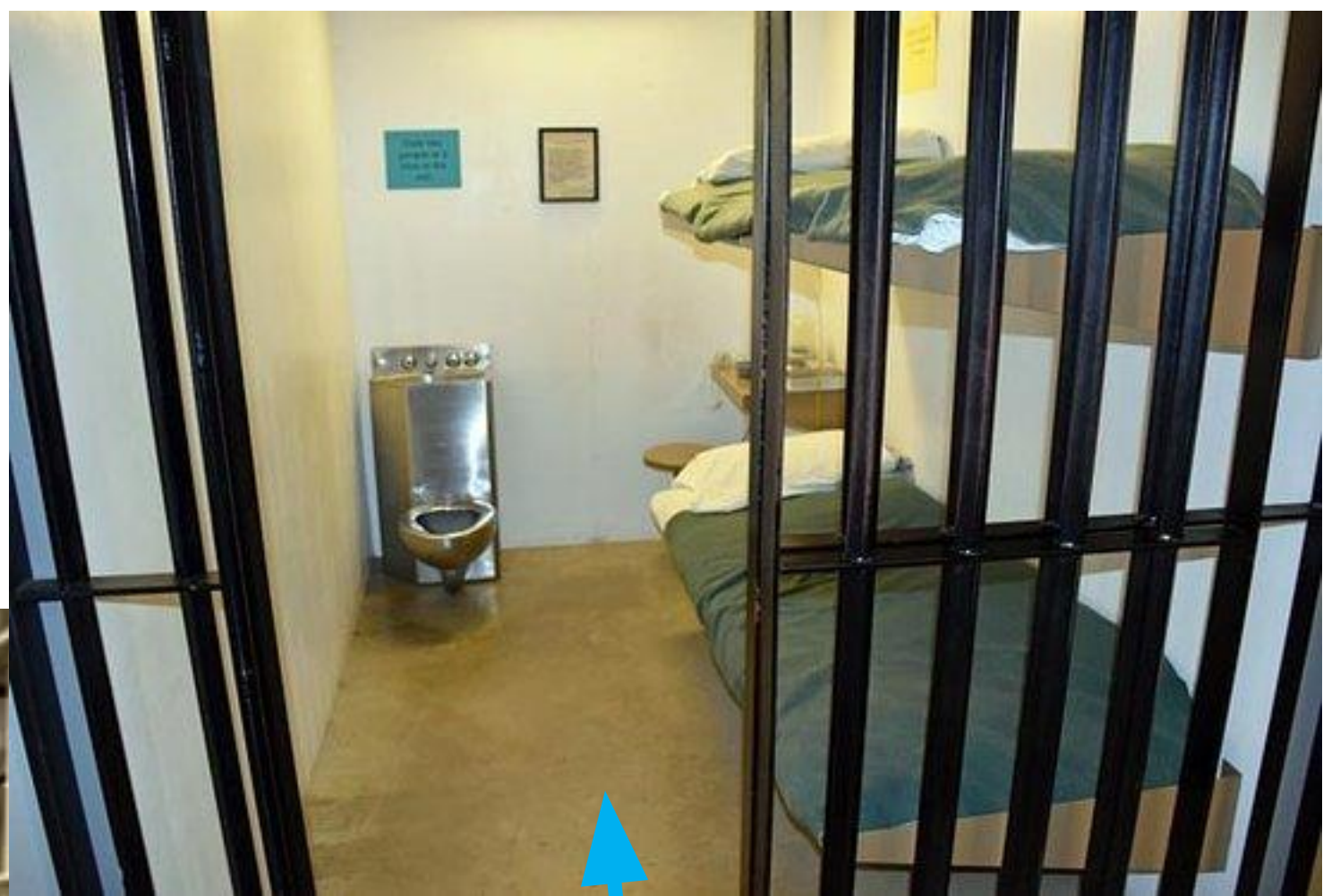
Yes. My friend is a lawyer :)
