- By learning physics, we become better problem solvers and critical thinkers.



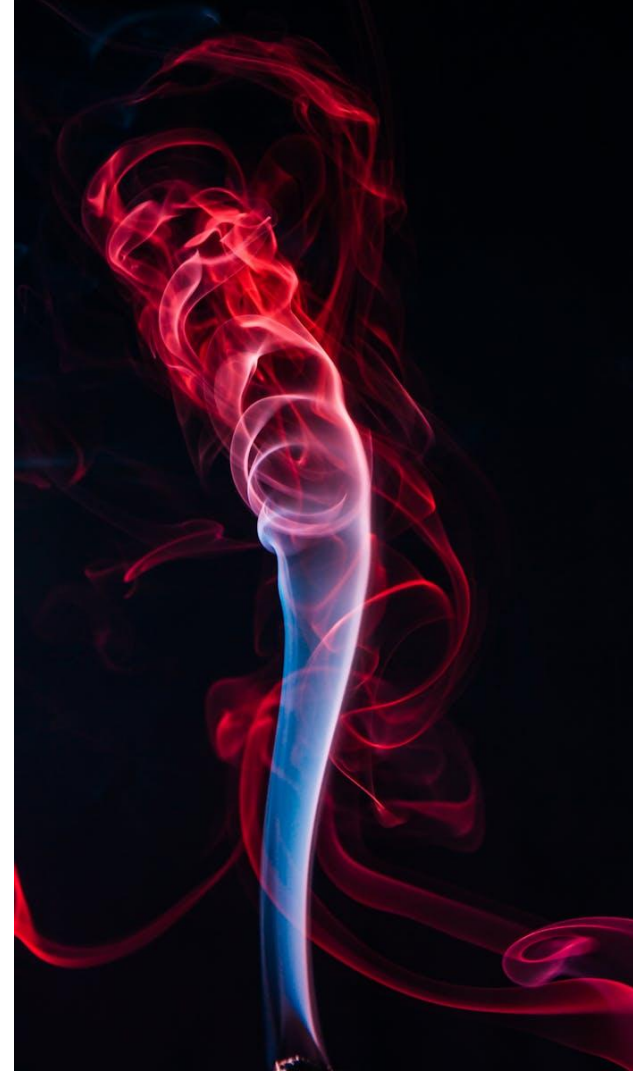
Energy and Its Forms

- Understanding energy is key to solving problems in everyday life and science.



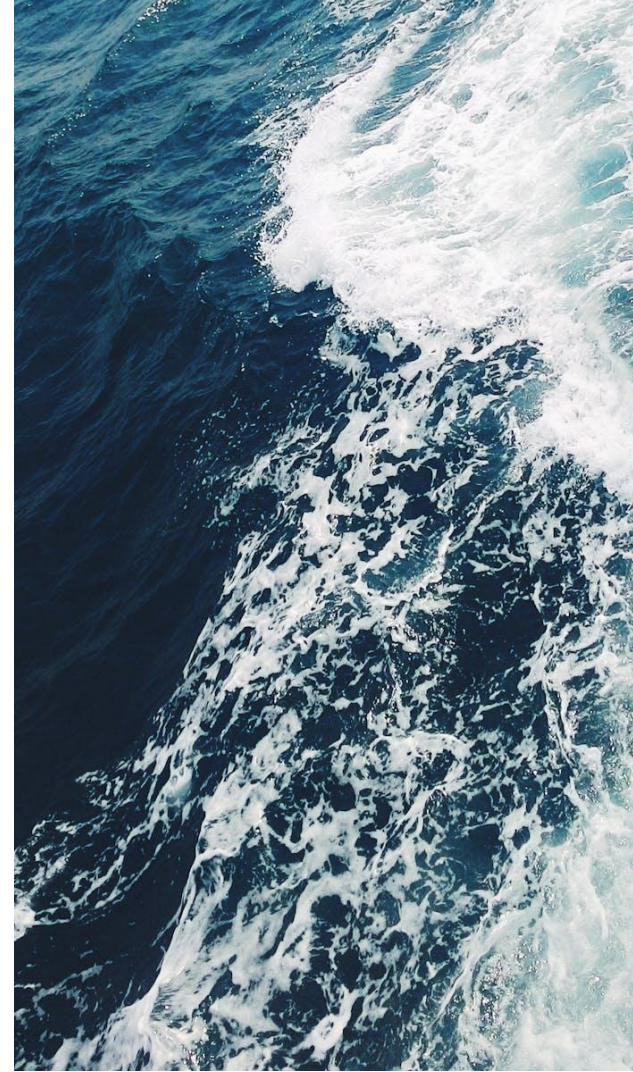
The Laws of Motion
