# Operational Data Standard (ODS): Streamlined transit operations

## ODS goals

- 1 Create common standard for transit operational data
- 2 Improve efficiency in dispatching, planning, scheduling, driver shift management, and other back-end transit operations
- 3 Reduce the burden of generating transit operational data for FTA reporting

# Working Group Status

## Group work to-date

- Kicked off effort to release ODS v1 covering operational scheduling
- Scoped effort to include standard for drivers/rostering, yards/facilities, and runcutting/pull-in/pull-out
- Selected GTFS as framework for standardizing this data

# Working Group Status

## Since last meeting

- Proposal for GTFS Driver/Rostering released for comment
- First draft was open for comments between September 13 and September 24, 2021
- Cal-ITP has been responding to comments and proposing changes to draft in response

# Discussion

## Drivers/Rostering

- Drivers/Rostering is first of three planned additions for ODS
- Includes information about personnel to establish operator schedules in subsequent modules

# Discussion

## Feedback to First Draft

- Don't back-add info to existing files
- "Drivers" too limited
- Desire for clarity around use cases for employee data in proposal
- Add employee name to file
- Change seniority to be more flexible

# Discussion

## Open Questions

- How to represent employees?
- Support for creating a new file
- Opposition to adding employee info through reference to existing files



# Discussion

## Open Questions

- How to re-designate drivers.txt?
  - “Roster,” “Drivers,” “Operators” all have limitations and/or overloaded meanings
- Suggested replacements:
  - personnel.txt
  - employees.txt

# Discussion

## Open Questions

- Should employee names be in file?
- Support for including name of employee in GTFS extensions
- Requires decision(s) about preserving security of personally identifying information

# Discussion

## Open Questions

- Do we limit employees to drivers?
- Support for broadening category to include other on-board employees

# Discussion

## Open Questions

- How to distinguish between on-board employees?
- Proposals:
  - 1: String, agency decides how to identify individual employees
  - 2: Enum
    - a: binary (0, driver; 1, non-driver)
    - b: select from list (0, driver; 1, conductor; 2,...)

- Comments fully incorporated based on today's meeting
- Second draft will be open for comment October 4
