Area/ Trail Length	
Seasons to Visit	Year round; birding best spring to early summer
Habitat	Marsh, riparian
Viewing Highlights	Waterfowl and other marsh birds including Sora and Yellow-headed Blackbird.
Other Features	Interpretive signs, viewing platform.
Main Access	Silver Star Road (48th Avenue) east 3.3 km from Highway 97, left onto L&A Road, then north another 1.7 km to Rimer Road. There is a small pullout by the mailboxes on the left side of L&A Road. Do not block access or get in the way of mailbox users.

Cautions	The marsh on the south side of Rimer Road is a Regional Park, but the north side is private property. View the marsh from the road only.
Jurisdiction	Regional District of North Okanagan, private property
