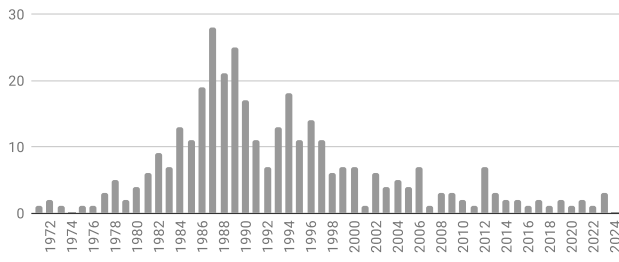

Terminology: When talking about videos about videos, things can get confusing.

Episode: a numbered episode of BOTW

Posting: any video listed in the BOTW playlist in Youtube, episodes and extras.

Video: something that the gang watches that isn't a movie: blackspine, etc.

Film: an actual movie that the gang watches

1987 is the year with the most films/videos reviewed at 28.

But, 1993 is the average production year of the films/videos reviewed.

On average Jay, Mike, & Rich are 46 years old. So they are reviewing movies mostly from when they were around 9 to 15.

The earliest film reviewed was *Santa Claus* (1959).

After that the next earliest film reviewed was *Blood Shack*, aka *The Chooper* (1971).

According to this analysis, the average length of feature films has held steady at about 115 minutes since 1970.

And I'm willing to believe that, since the words "data science" are in the url.

So, 270 feature films at 115 minutes each, means that the gang has watched approximately 31050 minutes (518 hours) of crap.

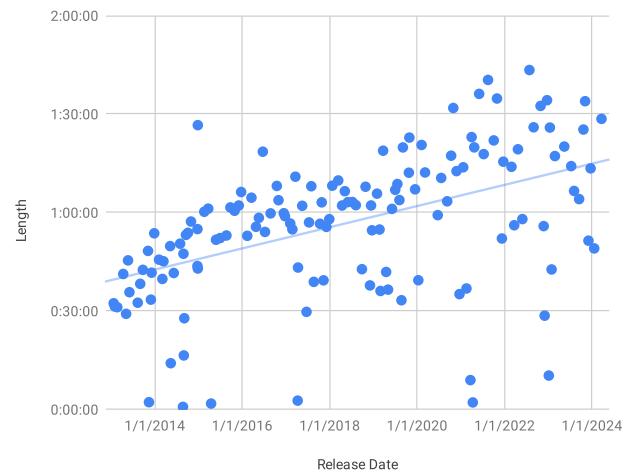
If we factor in all the blackspine and instructional videos, then we'll have to do some guessimating. I figure 10 minutes per video is reasonable.

So, 144 videos at 10 minutes each, means that the gang has watched approximately 1440 minutes (24 hours) of video crap.

That's a grand total of 542 hours of crap, over the past 11.8 years.

How Good Are These Movies?

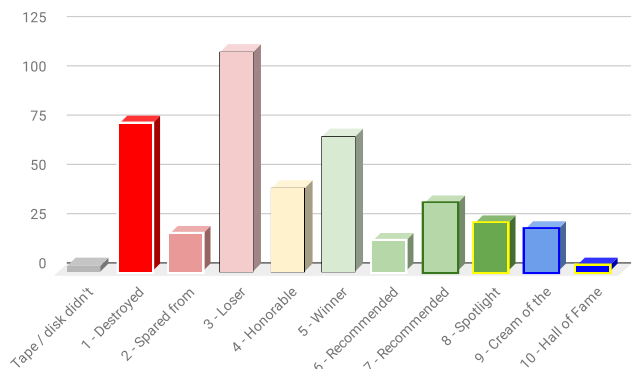
Recommendations and Honorable Mentions are subjectively based on myself and the creator of the original sheet by watching BOTW repeatedly and judging based on the panel hosts' reactions and comments upon their ultimate picks for BOTW and whether or not they seemed to possibly enjoy/recommend the films in question.

Ratings have been organized into the ten point system seen below. Whether or not the rating was objective or subjective and the rationale are listed.

Host recommendations are given priority in the ratings over winning. If there is a strong night there might be several films the panel recommends, but like the Highlander there can only be one Best of the Worst.

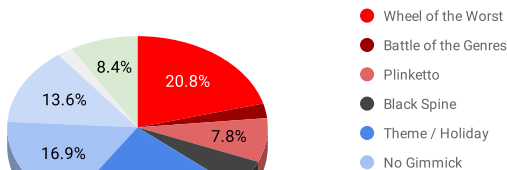

For our purposes Jim & Collin are treated as a combined being, as are Mack & Shawn.

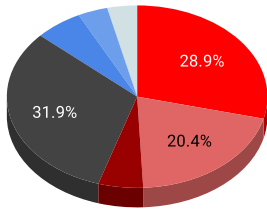
When a film fits into multiple genres, it was assigned to the genre that I judged "defined" the film the best.

For example, *Alien* would be assigned as sci-fi rather than horror because... reasons.



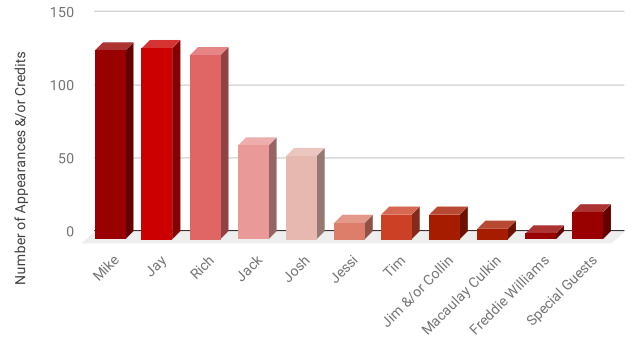
