





























































[1] full name of the character, without titles

[2] family name of character, so we can sort by it

[3] rank and name of most important title, e.g. "King of France"

[4] full list of other titles

[5] name of realm or person (full name or code) this person is (supposed to be) loyal to

[6] date of birth of this character, year suffices

[7] copy+paste formula to automatically display age (current or age at time of death)

[8] date of death, if historical. If no historical one, leave blank.

if the death age was originally unknown and you added it in, please colour the cell the same way as a fictional character cell.

[9] Level 1: claim leaders, their spouse, and their heirs.

Level 2: powerful other characters with titles, children and direct family of level 1 characters.

Level 3: lesser nobility who hold titles, family of level 1 & 2 characters.

Level 4: family of level 3 nobles, others

Level 5: dead people

[10] 4-5 character unique code, see notes. If a cell is red there's a duplicate.

(Optional) format: first 2 letters of first name, first 1 letter of last name, 1 number:

John Doe -> JOD1

please choose a unique combination of 4-6 characters to identify them by, so you can easily link kids and parents, wives and husbands, without actually confusing their names

[11] full name or code of father

[12] full name or code of mother

[13] full name or code of current spouse

[14] If historical, you can link a source page for people to learn more about this character

[15] Mark X if character did not exist in history

[16] Result on babyroll fertility roll if applicable

[17] Babyroll used for this character's birth

[18] Mother Rolls - Baby rolls made with this character as the mother. List the mother roll result.

[19] If you have done more than 8 mother rolls for this character, add a column to the right
