Election results are from <u>Dave Leip's Atlas</u>. Elections where state legislatures directly awarded their electoral votes are denoted with the winner or party.

Partisanship Score (P.S.) compares the percentage point difference in the two-party-only vote share margin between Democrats and Republicans/Whigs in each state with the national result in a given year. P.S. values are less useful in elections between the mid-19th and mid-20th centuries that featured strong third parties and major parties that weren't on the ballot in every state.

State regions are <u>from the U.S. Census Bureau</u> with Delaware, Maryland, and Washington, D.C. reassigned to the Northeast.

Gray candidate names denote incumbents.
