We are now attempting to address it with new negotiation rules but IHS can't meet with us. Need rules done before March but IHS can't meet. Likely won't have negotiations for '20. 907-378-2103" Nearly everyone is furloughed at BIA's ABQ office on 12th Street (HR, Div of Environmental Safety, Facilities, Construction, Land titles and Records, Accounting, etc). "One thing people who are furloughed are doing is applying for unemployment and / or local credit unions are giving 90 days of 0% interest loans. If this isn't resolved, next week I'll be going to my credit union to take a loan to cover my bills (student loans, mortgage, groceries, car payment, insurance, gas, etc.).
