EVENT DESCRIPTION: The USF Health Service Corps is collaborating with One Blood, Donate Life Florida and the Icla da Silva Foundation, Inc.(a Recruitment Center for Be the Match Registry) to offer new virtual Give Life Day information sessions for USF students, faculty & staff. During each session, participants will learn:

- **WHY** - The importance and benefits of donating blood and joining the Be the Match and Donate Life Florida Registries;

- **HOW** you can help:

- o WHERE & WHEN in Tampa you can donate blood with OneBlood;
- o HOW you can join the Be the Match Registry and save the life of a patient through the bone marrow donation process;
- o HOW you can join the Donate Life Florida Registry and the organ tissue and cornea recovery process.
