Mirny Pops	Band	Ruled Out	Dutch band active in the mid 80s. Contacted by reddit user AngolBaoCanuck. Not TMS.
Molken	Band	Ruled Out	Obscure German post-punk band from the 80s. Guitarist contacted by Train and called by jehymthos. The guitarist replied and said it's not Molken. Ruled out.
Moody Media/DMM	Company	Ruled Out	Managed in-store music for Whole Foods in 2003, where one YouTube user said they were "100% sure" the song was played. Investigated by a friend of ulits73K who works for the company, did not have the song.
Muse Präsentiert - Diner a la Carte	Album (Compilation)	Ruled Out	German new wave compilation album, released in 1985. Features a song titled "Wie der Wind" by Anastasi, a band that cannot be found elsewhere. Discogs uploader message by bitismydog970, album does not contain our song.
Najamitsu	Band	Ruled Out	Was on list of possible bands by Last Media Record Discort, now ruled out.
New Order	Band	Ruled Out	Was on list of possible bands by Last Media Record Discort. Contacted, did not make the song.
New Substance	Band	Ruled Out	Confirmed to not be the band by a forum user.
Nick Cave	Band	Ruled Out	From Gabriel Vieira's YouTube description, no evidence provided.
Nicklas Tevlera	Person	Ruled Out	Troll who claimed to have made the song.
Nigel Ayers	Band	Ruled Out	Was on list of possible bands by Last Media Record Discort, now ruled out.
Orchestral Maneuvres in the Dark	Band	Ruled Out	Fairly popular British band originally active from 1978-1996. Did not make the song.
Ortega	Band	Ruled Out	Was on list of possible bands by Last Media Record Discort. Contacted, did not make the song.
Overkill	Band	Ruled Out	Has a song called "There's No Tomorrow". Not our band/song.
PAL	Band	Ruled Out	Was on list of possible bands by Last Media Record Discort, now ruled out.
Parental Guidance	Band	Ruled Out	Has a song named "ear it down", Discogs seller message by u/wh0rnc and found not to be the song. Song lengths do not match either.
Paul Baskerville	Person	Ruled Out	Heard NPRC radio show which allegedly first played the song, after being contacted by Gabriel he played it on his current radio show. Nobody knows the song, not even him. [6]
Perfect Vision	Band	Ruled Out	Suggested on Reddit, vocals do not match.
Peter Murphy	Band	Ruled Out	From Gabriel Vieira's YouTube description, no evidence provided.
Peter Urban	Person	Ruled Out	Author and presenter of NPRC Music For Young People since 1974. Same show as Paul Baskerville's. Contacted, did not recognize the song.
Pia Lundflötr	Person	Ruled Out	Co-author of "Love on Sale" by Philip Baa. She did not recognize the song but said she would forward it to her colleagues.
PlanetNameDesire	YouTube Channel	Ruled Out	Has a lot of obscure music uploaded, contacted by Udamabody but they don't know the song.
Portan Bizarre / Clubs Wampers	Band/Person	Ruled Out	Very similar vocals to TMS vocalist. Contacted by KoobTeraz, he responded saying he's not behind the song. Was interested in joining the Discort server. UPDATE: He joined the server and will ask around his friends whether they recognize the song.
Post-Punk Classics	Blog	Ruled Out	Blog that focuses on obscure post-punk bands. Has been contacted, did not recognize the song.
RARE 1983 SNIPPET FOUND	Reddit Post	Ruled Out	Supposed snippet of mystery band live in concert. Found to be live footage of the band Emerson, Lake and Palmer from the early 1970s with a static effect added. [7]
Rae Ho	Band	Ruled Out	Contacted, not our band.
Real Life	Band	Ruled Out	Was on list of possible bands by Last Media Record Discort, now ruled out.
Remain in Silence	Band	Ruled Out	From a 1986 German compilation. Investigated by nowhereman378349, ruled out.
Richard Witts	Person	Ruled Out	Music production professor at Liverpool university, used to be in the band "The Passage". Said he doesn't know who it is.
Rickengard	YouTube Channel	Ruled Out	Does not know/have our song.
Roman of ForgottenSteel	Person	Ruled Out	German mail-order music shop. Did not recognize the song.
Rough Enough	Band	Ruled Out	Contacted by Train, ruled out, wrote a song called "Caught In A Play" which would fit if TMS was about Les Misérables. The artist responded and said it's a reggae song.
Schatten Under Era	Band	Ruled Out	Contacted by Train, never heard our song, but mentioned that it is professionally produced, ruled out.
Sat Lovers & Giants	Band	Ruled Out	Emailed by u/keozis, confirmed it wasn't them.
Scarlet Masque	Band	Ruled Out	Similar sound. Only made 3 songs, all of which are available online. Not our band.
Seppo Lind	Person	Ruled Out	Subreddit troll.
Seas	Band	Ruled Out	Band who released a demo titled "Wave of Fear" that was played on Musik für Junge Leute in 1984. Contacted, not our band.
Shadow Show	Band	Ruled Out	Band/person who created similar music in the 80's. Contacted by Toad and ruled out.
Short Romans (Dirk Dräger)	Band/Person	Ruled Out	German new wave band from the same time with similar style and vocals. Singer contacted and doesn't know the song.
Silent Runners	Band	Ruled Out	Lesser known new wave band based in BAFW. It sounds similar to our song. Has been contacted by EvanC019, did not make our song.
Silent Runners	Band	Ruled Out	Contacted, confirmed to not have made the song.
Sincere	Band	Ruled Out	Investigated, not our band.
Sinking Ships	Band	Ruled Out	The band responsible for the song BoC's Societas X Tape. None of their songs are TMS, but they had an unreleased "I2" in the works. All info found out by KoobTeraz available in the Discort announcements.
Slices of Mercy	Band	Ruled Out	From Gabriel Vieira's YouTube description, no evidence provided.
Soggy Porridge	Band	Ruled Out	Contacted, not our band.
Solo Wind	Band	Ruled Out	Has a 1984 song called "Run" with the "Wind". Not our song.
Spoken	Radio Show	Ruled Out	Radio show on Heavens which ran from 1983-1991. All playlists are publicly available online and have been searched through. Not all songs & artists have audio available but no songs really stuck out and Darius said he never listened to this show. Also these recordings don't have the 10kHz line.
Stefan Kühne	Person	Ruled Out	DJ who played on Musik für Junge Leute with Paul Baskerville. Died a couple of years ago.
Steve Thompson	Person	Ruled Out	Has a song called "Ride the Wind". Contacted by supper maloo, not our song.
Sunset	Band	Ruled Out	Has an album named "The Wind", purchased by u/insanehans9494 and found not to be a match. Wrong genre too. Has been posted to YouTube.
Stigastigen Jung	"Band"	Ruled Out	u/Rone, Rottenberry - His uncle who has a large music collection says the song is by his band. No trace of said band can be found. Album cover has a painting of a girl on it. Awaiting further information. On 5th August Gene_Rottenberry delivered the pictures of the album. Confirmed hoax by Rock or Rama Records.
Sven Friedrich	Band	Ruled Out	From Gabriel Vieira's YouTube description, no evidence provided.
System 56	Band	Ruled Out	Contacted, not our band.
Systems of Romance, vol. 1-6	V/A Compilation	Ruled Out	Searched by KoobTeraz, our song is not there.
Seavily Feet	Band	Ruled Out	Found by u/Profibundemium, Has song named "Time in Time Out". https://www.discogs.com/release/249590/ , is a jazz band.
Tava Dün - Hunted Mind/Age	Album	Ruled Out	Seller on Discogs contacted by Koob Teraz on August 30, 2019. Not our band.
The Brigade	Band	Ruled Out	Found by u/Profibundemium, https://www.discogs.com/The-Brigade-Product-of-Evolution/release/7951614/ , Has a female vocalist.
The Children of Power	Band	Ruled Out	Released an album called "Innocence", which one YouTube user recognized as featuring a vocalist similar to the song's vocalist. Contacted by hawk1, did not make our song.
The Commot Front	Person	Ruled Out	Claims his grandfather was the author of the song. Contacted in e-mail, most likely just a troll. [8]
The Damned	Band	Ruled Out	British band with similar sound. Vocals do not match, also stylistically different during the period when our song would have been released.
The Danse Society	Band	Ruled Out	New wave band from the 1980s, similar sound. Contacted by rylabare2178, not our band.
The Dismen	Band	Ruled Out	British new wave/post-punk band from the 1980s. Has song called "A Year Without Summer". Seller on Discogs was contacted by LuLaBot, confirmed to not be our band/song.
The Dirty Reds	Band	Ruled Out	Scottish band with similar sound. Different style and vocals.
The Editors	Band	Ruled Out	From Gabriel Vieira's YouTube description, no evidence provided.
The Eternal	Band	Ruled Out	Contacted, did not make our song.
The Fire Engines	Band	Ruled Out	Scottish band with guitarist from The Dirty Reds - Same style but different vocals.
The Fox Rotarians/Alexander Hummberg	Band/Person	Ruled Out	One Reddit/Discord user has apparently made contact with The Fox Rotarians, who claim that a man named Alexander Hummberg is behind the song. Confirmed to be a troll.
The Game	Band	Ruled Out	From Gabriel Vieira's YouTube description, no evidence provided.
The Grim Biscuits/Dead Neighbours	Band	Ruled Out	Predecessors to Lovelife. Vocals of Dead Neighbours songs found to not match vocals of mystery song. Dead Neighbours, The Grim Biscuits, and Lovelife shared the same vocalist. [9]
The Kampen	Band	Ruled Out	False band suggested by a troll.
The Kaz Radge Band	Band	Ruled Out	Known by many names: Edgar Helwig, Olyffe, Edgar Zakaak. Weird lead that led to nothing but fake hype. Still pretty dope.
The Mask (Belgium)	Band	Ruled Out	Post-punk/new-wave band based on Discogs by Jariusz_May2957. Active during mystery song's suspected production date. Vocals found to not match mystery song.
The Name	Band	Ruled Out	Investigated, did not make the song.
The Numero Group	Label	Ruled Out	Chicago based label specialising in the release of rare private press records. Contacted by u/Drunk_Romanian, did not know the song.
The Pies	Band	Ruled Out	u/wild_con_came - Liverpool band in the 80s who don't officially release any music until 2016. Vocals not similar.
The Public Address	Band	Ruled Out	Has a song titled "Take It Out". Band member contacted, not our band.
The Red Guitars	Band	Ruled Out	Produced a song named "Check It Out". The song was found and isn't the mystery song.
The Squeeze	Band	Ruled Out	Has a song called "There's No Tomorrow". Not our band/song.
The Twins	Band	Ruled Out	Similar sound. Contacted, confirmed to not have made our song.
The Very Unknown Band	"Band"	Ruled Out	Uploaded our song to YouTube, iTunes, and Spotify. Is currently (and unfairly) making money through these uploads. They have nothing to do with our band - we ask that you ignore all their uploads of TMS, as they are monetized. See the note on this cell for more info. [10]
This is What I Call Minimal 80s!	Album	Ruled Out	Very large compilation album, did not contain the song.
Ti Tac	Band	Ruled Out	Italiano/new wave band that released a song titled "A Song For The Sun" in August 1984. Not our band.
Tumelation	Band	Ruled Out	Vocals do not match.
Turquoise Days	Band	Ruled Out	From Gabriel Vieira's YouTube description, no evidence provided.
Tuthe US	Band	Ruled Out	Tyngsvald band. Did not make our song.
Twelve Drummers Drumming	Band	Ruled Out	Similar sound. Contacted by Lydia, not our band.
Ul Rehberg	Person	Ruled Out	Owner of a store which Paul Baskerville frequently borrowed records/tapes. Contacted by LukaRuso, could not provide any info.
Venom	Band	Ruled Out	Was on list of possible bands by Last Media Record Discort, now ruled out.
Very on Demand	Label	Ruled Out	Contacted by user asainwright, did not know the song.
Westdeutsche Christen	Band	Ruled Out	Obscure German new wave band from the 80s. Contacted by Train and re-contacted by d235. Not our band.
Wide Angle Lens	Band	Ruled Out	Has a song called "Escape from Your World". Not our song.
Wildfly Obscure	Blog	Ruled Out	Blog dedicated to obscure pop/rock music. Has been contacted.
Win	Band	Ruled Out	One of Dave Henderson's former bands, as brought up by former BSC member Christopher Home. Completely different style: made synth-pop.
Winifred Hoffman	Person	Ruled Out	Claims to possibly recognize the song as the b-side of a demo tape, currently searching for said demo tape in his collection. Could not find the song.
XLS	Band	Ruled Out	Released song called "The Sun", someone who owns the tape was contacted by Sven Wonders, female singer, ruled out.
Xulas & Pontades	Band	Ruled Out	Mentioned on "Whisky" video, ruled out.
Yazoo	Band	Ruled Out	Lead singer is a woman.
Zerra 1	Band	Ruled Out	Ruled out by Lydia and her brother.
zetaone	Band	Ruled Out	Russian Band - Similar sound but never sang in English as far as anyone knows. Different vocalist.

What does this spreadsheet keep track of?

This spreadsheet keeps track of all possible leads related to the Most Mysterious Song on the Internet that have been contacted or investigated.

How often is the spreadsheet updated?

The spreadsheet is updated every time a new lead, or new information about a lead, is found.

What do the different statuses of the leads mean?

A **Possible Lead** is either a band or musical artist that may have made the song or another entity that may have information about the song. Possible Leads are in the process of being investigated and/or have been contacted but have not responded yet.

A **Confirmed Lead** is a lead from which information about the song has been gathered.

A **Ruled Out** lead did not make the song (in the case of bands/musical artists) or does not have any information about the song (in the case of other entities). A lead can be ruled out through investigation or through direct contact.

A **Ruled Out (Very Likely)** lead is a lead that cannot be directly contacted but, through investigation, has been found to have a 90-99% chance of being ruled out.

A **Dead Lead** is a lead that has not responded to us when contacted or is no longer being investigated. Note that Dead Leads are neither confirmed nor ruled out, and can be revived if new information becomes available.
