All planets except for Roshar have a year the same length as that of Earth		Elantris	"Not thousands of years before Hero of Ages", so I'm guessing more than a couple hundred but less than 2000. I picked 1525 years before Hero of Ages for a nice round number (that's 500 years before Rashek took the power at the Well of Ascension).	The Recreance is "ancient history" but not 4000 years ago. Tanavast died millenia ago, and we assume the Recreance was prior to that, so it must have happened more than 2000 years ago. Both this date and the death of Tanavast are the latest possible dates that it could've happened. They could not have been too long before since the Recreance is not like 4000 years ago.

		White Sand	This is one of the earliest stories. We know now that White Sand takes place before Elantris. We have few clues as to how long before. Based on the Ars Arcanum in the 10th Anniversary Edition of Elantris, it seems like Khriss has been traveling for a while already. I have therefore placed White Sand 1000 years before Elantris.	
		Warbreaker	We know it's after Mistborn and before The Way of Kings. I assumed, based on Vasher's respected position in the Kholin army, that he's been on Roshar for a while as of Words of Radiance. I further assumed that Vasher spent a fair amount of time on Naithis after the events of Warbreaker (though this may eventually be proven wrong in Nightblood). I picked a somewhat random number that was a fairly long time before Words of Radiance (124 years).	
		Nightblood	I picked ten years after Warbreaker as a reasonable seeming guess, but I also wouldn't be surprised if this picks up much sooner after Warbreaker either.	
		Shadows for Silence	We know basically nothing other than it's before The Way of Kings. I arbitrarily placed it after Warbreaker for no particular reason other than the phrasing "in the latter half of things" makes me want to put it as late in the timeline as possible (relative to other books).	
		The Way of Kings	I placed this at 324 after Hero of Ages so that Mistborn Era 2 would fit in between Stormlight 5 and Stormlight 6. It may actually be a few years earlier so that Mistborn Era 2 is closer to Stormlight 6.	
		Stormlight 5-10	The first five books take place over a period of a few years. There is then a fifteen year gap between Stormlight 5 and Stormlight 6. I assumed (I can't find the source at the moment) that the back half of Stormlight Archive would take place over a similar amount of time as the front half.	
		The Lost Metal	The other Mistborn Era 2 books have picked up shortly after the previous book, so I assumed that pattern would continue.	
		Mistborn Era 3	Based on the tech level change and how long that took to accomplish in our world. But it could be much shorter as they have Harmony helping them out. Or it could be much longer if something catastrophic happens during The Lost Metal. WoB puts it tenatively around 50 years.	
		Sixth of the Dusk	Placed relatively shortly before Mistborn Era 4.	
		Mistborn Era 4	Very hard to estimate. I would guess not less than 1000 years after Mistborn Era 3 because FTL is hard to develop, but it could be as long as 1000 years after it. We don't have FTL so it's hard to say how long it would take to develop it. Based on a WoB that gives the entire Cosmere timeline as spanning a 10,000 year period, I have placed it ~10,000 years after the Prelude to Stormlight Archive.
