**MIRIAM FIRE & CLEAR FORK FIRE IN GOAT ROCKS WILDERNESS**

**9/13/18 (PCTA)** : The PCT is closed for 16.5 miles from Elk Pass (mile 2278.5) to White Pass at Highway 12 (mile 2295).

The Miriam Fire is burning just to the east of the trail. The Clear Fork Fire is burning to the west of the trail. Fire fighters have partially contained these fires, but they are still burning in close proximity to the PCT.

Detour information

Exiting the PCT at Elk Pass, travel NW on Trail #79 (Coyote Trail). Follow Trail #79 past Chimney Rock to the junction with Trail #78 (Packwood Trail) to the junction with Trail #76 (Clear Lost Trail). At Clear Lost Trailhead either take travel on Hwy 12 to White Pass or walk Trail #60 to rejoin the PCT at Sand Lake.

Hiking northbound from the PCT on the detour, water was found at the following locations:

**MIRIAM FIRE (see update above)**

8/11/18 (Halfmile) : The new (2nd) alternate around the Miriam Fire is about 17.5 miles long (including the 3.5 mile Hwy 12 road walk) bypassing 16.2 miles of the PCT.

The Forest Service recommends the following fire detour.  
"Hikers heading North from Suiattle Pass should take the Hart Lyman Trail to Holden Village. From Holden, hike 10 Mile Creek to Hilgard Pass and down Company Creek to the Stehekin Road at Harlequin Bridge. There is a shuttle bus stop at Harlequin Bridge. Hikers could also take the Holden shuttle bus to Lucerne, and the Lady of the Lake Ferry to Stehekin."  
Information for when you're in Holden Village  
Meals/services may be available in Holden Village. There is a Forest Service campground available 3/4mile west of Holden Village, at the Hart Lyman trailhead. No camping is allowed in Holden Village.

8/30/18 (PCTA) : Starting 8/31/18, the closure in Pasayten Wilderness is being reduced in size. Yes, a route to the northern terminus of the PCT just reopened! This page now reflects the new situation.

The Pacific Crest Trail is closed for 17.5 miles from near the Slate Peak Lookout (mile 2623.6) to near Woody Pass (mile 2641) due to the Holman Fire burning on the PCT at Holman Pass.

**Detour discussion**

Online mapping tools indicate that this detour is 21.4 miles and bypasses 17.5 miles of the PCT.

From Hart's Pass, take the Buckskin Ridge Trail #498 for ~2 miles to the Whistler Cutoff Trail #575. Take the Whistler Cutoff Trail #575 for ~2.3 miles to Robinson Creek Trail #478. Head north on Robinson Creek Trail #478 for ~10.2 miles to Rock Creek Trail #473. Head west on Rock Creek Trail #473 for ~6.9 miles to Woody Pass on the PCT Trail #2000. Head north on the PCT #2000 to the Canadian Border.

9/14/18 (Mads) : A few notes on the Holman fire detour, that I unfortunately first found time to pen down while on an airplane:

**DEFINITIONS:**

First leg = north by northeast headed long stretch

Second leg = westbound stretch

**MAPS:**

I noted three inconsistencies between PCTA's mapping and signposted route:

1. The PCT is closed earlier than on the map. Instead you are dirt road walking for a while before getting to the actual detour.
2. The signposted route goes down and crosses the middle fork a bit earlier than on the map.
3. The signposted route gets you back on the west side of the middle fork to circumnavigate an older landslide area. There's an unfinished bridge there.

I'd call the detour easier than average Washington. All crossings dry.

**CAMPING**

First leg has a approximately seven campsites. Biggest ones near the end and first one shortly after crossing the middle fork. Second leg is almost devoid of camping sites. I only saw a single small one.

**WATER**

Plentiful on first leg with maybe one or two sources per mile. Second leg has less water. Maybe six in total with the majority in first half. Unfortunately, I stopped watching for sources midway. I'd fill up on the first source after the point where forest turns into scattered trees.

Hope I got everything down right, but no guarantees given.
