Habitat	Interior Douglas-fir, alkaline lake, wetlands.
Viewing	Colony of about 80 Eared Grebes.
Highlights	April to June and August – Black-bellied Plovers, Dowitchers
Other Features	
Main Access	28 km west of Highway 97 on Meadow Lake Road (good gravel road); turnoff 16 km north of Clinton or 15 km south of 70 Mile House.
Secondary Accesses	Meadow Lake Road connections to the west to Dog Creek, Jesmond and Gang Ranch
Cautions	Grebe colony is sensitive to disturbance during nesting season and boaters must stay well back. No mobile phone service in this area.
Jurisdiction	Crown and private land.

Facilities	None. Basic services in Clinton and 70 Mile House.
Other Recreational Activities	Fishing.
Other Connections	Waterfowl viewing in other lakes and ponds in area.
