The size of the buttons makes this a bit challenging however. Presentations are wonderful to view on the iPad, you just can't edit them. "View Together" is not supported. View only Hope you have small fingers! Works fairly well Google Image Search and Picassa Web Albums are the only options that work. Upload doesn't link to Camera Roll and URL doesn't support copy/paste. Buttons are difficult to navigate, especially in pull-down menus. Works surprisingly well!
