Organization and Membership. The Educational Policy and Curriculum Committee (EPCC) shall consist of fourteen members, including eight teaching faculty with representation from each college as follows: two three teaching faculty from the College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences, two faculty from the College of Science, Technology, Mathematics, and Health Sciences, two faculty from the College of Business, and two faculty from the College of Education (at least four of the teaching faculty members must be tenured); one library faculty, two students, the Registrar, and an administrative professional member who has an understanding of the unique needs of online students as they pertain to curriculum and other EPCC issues. In addition, the Provost or his/her designee shall serve ex officio without vote. The Provost's Office shall provide staff support for the Committee. Teaching faculty members shall be elected by their respective Colleges to two-year terms.

QUORUM EPCC defines a quorum to be majority of voting members (i.e. (6) six voting members). Once the committee loses quorum, no business will be conducted.
