Geographical Description	Fraser Lowlands.
Area/ Trail Length	
Seasons to Visit	Hatchery open year round, best viewing of Chinook and Coho salmon in October and November. Weaver Creek spawning channels open only during fish spawning activity in autumn, generally mid-October to November..
Habitat	Natural and artificial riparian habitat, spawning and rearing tanks.
Viewing Highlights	Several species of salmonids are hatched and reared in this facility for release into the wild. Self-guided tour of hatchery with display panels. Channels to enhance salmonid spawning opportunities. American Dippers feed on the eggs on the channels.
Other Features	Weaver Lake nearby has a rustic campsite and a walking trail around the lake; access via rough road.

Main Access Hatchery: on Morris Valley Road, 4.5 north from Highway 7.
Spawning channels: 11.5km from Highway 7.
