## Information about this Tracker

**Why we created this Service Change Tracker (what it is and is not):** This tracker is intended to provide information to members and partners of the Coalition on Homelessness (including 211 and local government) about changes in the network of homeless-specific services in King County in response to the COVID-19 outbreak. This tracker helps us see shifts in what was already an insufficient network of care, but does not fully describe the scope and nature of unmet needs for our neighbors experiencing homelessness. While we hope this is a useful tool and resource to make good referrals and connections, **we did NOT design it to be printed for distribution as a resource list, because this information changes too rapidly and capacity is too limited, especially in terms of shelter and hygiene services.**

**Process:** Coalition on Homelessness staff contacted knowledgeable staff at each program or agency who shared details over the phone or entered information directly into our google form (<https://bit.ly/covidchanges>). Thank you to all staff who have adjusted programs and services to maintain some ability to serve people during a global pandemic and public health emergency on top of the crisis of homelessness. We understand that as programs continue to adapt and circumstances continue to change, also change.

**We first collected information between March 26 and April 9, 2020, and first posted the tracker publicly on 4/16/20. "Last updated" column indicates when each entry was last updated.**

## General notes:

**Addresses/contact information:** Not included in this document. Please use your network, 211, or search to find. We have also not made note of populations served, as this has not changed.

**Day Centers:** most have limited capacity due to social distancing measures even if service hours and types of service are unchanged. About half have closed access for the general public and are only allowing people who are established clients or guests, or who are connected to other services (such as shelter) at the same site or agency to use the facilities. In several cases this is because the location has transitioned to serve a limited number of people 24/7.

**Shelter:** There is functionally no shelter available on request for adults, including youth and young adults. Because there is essentially no client turnover, most programs are not accepting new referrals. Currently shelter and diversion resources available for families through the Family Shelter Intake line (managed by Mary's Place): 206.245.1026. This tab currently contains limited information for two reasons: significant program changes and lack of capacity. There are significant changes in the shelter system throughout King County due to efforts to reduce the numbers of people sharing one room or building because of concerns about congregate settings and the spread of the coronavirus. Multiple shelters where the physical space did not allow people to spread out enough or did not allow for reasonable air circulation have moved to new locations, or split into two; some overnight only programs have transitioned to 24/7 to allow people to have somewhere to stay. Some programs are now located in hotels or motels. We are not listing transitional housing or permanent supportive housing or certain confidential DV shelters.

**Hygiene Centers:** Restrooms, showers, and laundry services are very hard to come by all over King County. Almost all public buildings (libraries, community centers, other facilities) are closed. Day and hygiene centers now serve fewer people (and some are closed altogether) because of the necessity to limit numbers of people in the space, enhanced sanitation protocols, and shifts in service delivery with public health guidance. Many programs have lost volunteers and staffing is limited. Other reduction in access is due to closure of businesses where people could previously sometimes use a bathroom, fill a water bottle, wash up, sit down, or plug in a phone. Publicly accessible amenities such as gas stations that used to provide access to a restroom because they served food no longer do so.

**Tent Cities/Tiny House Villages/Safe Parking Programs:** This tab is not yet fully populated.

**Information not collected:** This note means Coalition staff did not collect information for that cell.
