Criteria (Column Headers)	Definition/description
Level	Funding source, type of agency.
Funding Source	Name of organization/agency offering the funding (use full name, no acronyms).
Program Name	Name of the grant/funding and brief description.
Application Submission Due Date	Deadline date for delivering grant application. (Formatted as a date, no narrative, to enable best sorting).
Concept Paper Due Date	Deadline date for submitting concept paper (if this is a prerequisite for application).
Other Key Dates	Additional dates provided that are important in the application process.
Link to Application Web Page	Official web page for the grant information.
Total Funding Amount	The total amount the funding agency is distributing. (Formatted as a number, no words, to enable best sorting).
Min/Max Funding Amount	The amount of funding available per applicant, including the minimum and maximum grant amount.
Eligible Applicants	List of types of organizations who qualify to receive this funding - who can apply. When possible, standardize the list so that it's easily scannable: 1. Local Government Entities 2. State Government Entities 3. Tribes or Tribal Governments 4. Non-profit Entities 5. For-profit Entities 6. Institutions of Higher Education 7. Other 8. Notes
Type of Program	What are the eligible activities for the funding specified: When possible, standardize the program type so that it's easily scannable: 1. Planning 2. Implementation 3. Education 4. Research 5. Other
Charging Equipment and Vehicle Type	Type of charging equipment allowed, and vehicle type requirements.
Matching Funds/Cost Sharing Requirements	Yes/No Conditional awards that require an organization to raise a specified portion of the funding in addition to the grant funding, look for requirements as a percentage of the total grant or project, requirements from a specific entity to provide the matching funds such as a local government or agency.
Stackable Funding Allowed	Yes/No Ability to combine funding from different sources for the same project or incentives.
Geographic or Location Requirements	Yes/No Are there specific geographic areas that are eligible for funding?
Equity/Priority Community Serving Requirements	Yes/No Is there a requirement to serve a certain % of Priority Community members (communities that are or have historically been underserved and may be defined using specific criteria such as Justice 40 or disadvantaged per Cal Enviroscreen)? Note that most funding RECOMMENDS serving priority communities.
Link to Workshop/Q&A Section	Any webinars/workshops to review grant requirements, link to invite and/or published Q&A list.
Contact Info - Email/Phone	Include contact information provided - email/phone.
Date Added	The specific date that this funding opportunity was added to the sheet.
