Language - consumers are people. food is not just a commondity. use new language to express the maginitude of impact that local food systems have on cultural behaviors and mindsets.	
Showing up in Hard Times - the impact of community will last beyond disaster. and people will remember that you fed them and provided for them during a time of struggle. yes, that means repeat customers but it also means deeper community.	
Education - reiterating the nutritional importance of fresh local food to consumers. not just stocking up on commodity foods.
