Instructions for Cub-E Infractions

- 1. Determine the Infraction Type and Point(s) to be administered.
 2. Once Infraction is determined, infraction strike will be added to the RSO's account for the current semester.
 2a. All infractions stay with the RSO for 1 semester.
 2b. The Programming Lead will email the RSO regarding the Strike Count and Infraction being added.
 3. If an RSO recieves 3 strikes in one semester, they are blocked from tabling for the rest of that semester. OASIS Staff will be responsible for emailing any RSO when they have reached 3 strikes and will be blocked for the remainder of the semester.
 4. All RSOs' strikes reset at the beginning of each semester.
